Inheritance law is very closely related to the scope of human life, because every human being has the legal event that is death. Patrilineal kinship system is an interesting system of father lineage, that the system prioritize man than woman. In the system that is embraced by society, tradition is considered to be valid. The purpose of writing this paper is to determine the inheritance practice in Muslim family law and how does Islam affect of the practice under Patrilineal system in Bali.

First sons became the only heir who get the inheritance. although some families use the Islamic law of inheritance. The strenght of local culture make it difficult to Islamic inheritance law to be applied in Muslim family in the village of South Denpasar District Sesetan Denpasar. However, the number of people studying at Islamic universities influence the division of inheritance system of Muslim families in the village of South Denpasar District Sesetan Denpasar.
