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This study aims to determine the psychological dynamics of mutual cooperation, especially in the disaster survivors. Psychological dynamics of mutual cooperation, is meant to describe the survivor mutual cooperation and the role of mutual cooperation, for survivors in the recovery process.

This research was conducted using qualitative method with phenomenological study approach. Subjects were catastrophic eruption of Mount Kelud survivor. The study was conducted in Pandansari, Ngantang, Malang. The data collection method used is to perform participant observation, in-depth interview and documentation.

From the analysis of this study concluded that mutual cooperation, is defined as a self help to entertainment for survivors from trauma and stressor. In mutual cooperation reflected in prosocial behavior that is helping, donating, sharing, and cooperating. With the role of mutual assistance that appear in the recovery process is social support, problem solving, stress coping and social relations.
