

ABSTRACT

Maklufah. 2013. *The Influence Of Peers Conformity To The Satisfaction Of Choosing Programs In Madrasah Aliyah Negeri (MAN) 2 Pamekasan Madura,*

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Teens and peers is something that can't be separated, teens often do anything to be accepted by the group or the environment even in terms of choosing program. Many young people, especially teenagers high school, they choose the program for participating peers. That occurs is due to the reluctance of the declining quality of learning and academic achievement as wrong in choosing programs. The purpose of this research 1) to know how much the level of peers conformity 2) to know the level of satisfaction of students on choosing program 3) to know the influence of peers conformity to the satisfaction of choosing program.

Research method was quantitative and data collection techniques with interviews, observation and questionnaires with psychological scale as the data collection instrument. Psychological scale used is in the form of Likert scale, 35 the number of items for peers conformity variables and 45 items to choose program satisfaction scale. This research used a population of 219 students MAN 2 Pamekasan, and 88 students as sample. Analysis of the data used is a simple regression techniques.

Results of this research found that the level of conformity to peer students MAN 2 Pamekasan who are at high category by 26%, the category of being 59% and 15% in the low category. While the level of satisfaction of choosing program, the high category by 17%, the category of being 70.5% and 12.5% in the low category. Simple regression analysis of peers conformity to the satisfaction of choosing program result of the regression coefficients (r_{xy}) of 0.264 to 0.007 $p < 0.05$. So that can be concluded that there is significant influence between peers conformity to the satisfaction of choosing program on students MAN 2 Pamekasan Madura. The higher the conformity that exists then the satisfaction of the students will also be higher.
