School became the right choice to be able to develop the potential of adolescence, whether cognitive, motor and affective, including emotional intelligence. The school also became one of the good place in developing social lives of students through the activities provided by the school. One of the school that develop student social lives is SMAN 1 Bangil, where the school has a variety of activities that can arouse students' social sensitivity. One of these activities are routine activities carried out by PMR (Red Cross Youth), where they held a blood donation is carried out every three months, as in January, they had a routine blood donation. Students enthusiastic in following this activity, many students are lining up to donate blood.

Blood donation is one of the concrete form of altruistic behavior, where they donate blood to others they do not know, this is not apart from a strong desire to give of themselves to do voluntarily. The purpose of this study was to determine and analyze the relationship of emotional intelligence with altruistic behavior.

The method used is data collection by using questionnaire. While the approach in this study was descriptive correlational quantitative research. To find a correlation between two variables, the researcher used *product moment correlation* method. The study showed that emotional intelligence is positively correlated to the altruistic behavior of the students of SMAN 1 Bangil.

The results of this study is that emotional intelligence level of students of SMAN 1 Bangil there are 82 students (83.67%) had high levels of emotional intelligence, 16 students (16.33%) had medium level of emotional intelligence, and 0 students is in the low level of emotional intelligence. Then on a scale of altruistic behavior as many as 78 students (79.59%) showed highm level of altruistic behavior, 20 students (20.41%) showed medium level of altruistic behavior, and 0 students (0%) are in low level of altruistic behavior. While the results of correlation between emotional intelligence with altruistic behaviors in students of SMAN 1 Bangil had significant correlation with obtained 0.530.
