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The actions of abuse occur anywhere, such as on the streets, in schools, even in residential complexes. Such actions may include verbal abuse (berate) and non-verbal violence (hitting, punching). Aggressiveness is done by the individual who has an impact on him as well. The bad impact of aggressiveness against the individual self is other people will stay away from actors who would only hurt others without thinking about the effect that will get after hurting someone else. Aggression by Berkowitz (1995) is any form of behavior intended to hurt someone, either verbally or non-verbally. One of the factors that influence the aggressiveness is parenting. This study aims to determine how the relationship between authoritarian parenting with aggressive behavior of street children in Griya Baca Malang.

The study uses a quantitative approach to correlation. The population in this research is assisted street children Griya Baca Malang. The Sample of this study is 30 children and retrieval of data using questionnaires, interviews, observation and documentation. And for the processing of the data is analyze with Pearson product of moment correlation and to test the reliability and power of different researcher using Cronbach alpha formula.

From the results of the study show that based on authoritarian parenting, most of 19 people (63%) had a relatively high aggressive behavior, 11 people (37%) were classified as having moderate to aggressive behavior, while aggressive behavior, relatively low or 0%. Aggressive behavior of street children are generally classified in the higher category. This is evidenced by the results of the analysis of the 30 items from each of the respondents that 30 children obtained 27 children (90%) for the high category, 1 child (3%) categorized, 2 children (7%) in the low category.

The results show that authoritarian parenting have relationship with aggressive behavior. It is evident from the analysis that has been done, it is known that authoritarian parenting relationship to aggressive behavior with a percentage of 51.4%. Based on statistical calculations found the value of r count (0.514) while p (0004) <r (0.05). It is means that there is a relationship between Authoritarian Parenting Behavior with Aggression In Griya Baca Malang is very significant, and thus it can be concluded that there is a positive relationship between Authoritarian Parenting Behavior Aggression with that hypothesis is accepted or proven. The higher of pearson authoritarian parenting, the higher of aggresion behavior.
