

ABSTRACT

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In the era of increasingly sophisticated and modern, men and women have equal rights to get the same education included in the study field of technology. Discrimination opportunities for women in science and technology will impede the progress of science itself that ultimately hamper efforts to meet the needs of human life. Independence and self etiket not to depend, is also a problem why women ultimately quite difficult occupy a strategic position. The students are ideally expected to be intelligent and independent. Emotional intelligence and independence both contain matters related to both moral and interconnected with each other. Emotional intelligence and independence are two aspects that support the development of mental ability for individuals to take maturity. And one of the barriers to self-adolescent girls is Cinderella complex. Cinderella complex tendency is a tendency of women to a psychic who depend on the show with a strong desire to maintain and protect other people especially by men she have believe that something from outsider wich help her.

The purpose of this reaserch was to determine the role of emotional intelligence with cinderella complex generation 2012 Informatics engineering Islamic State University Malang Maulana Malik Ibrahim

This type research uses a quantitative approach. This study uses a sample population, the subject is a student of Generation 2012 Informatics Engineering Department State Islamic University Malang Maulana Malik Ibrahim totaled 45 people. The data was collected with a Likert scale, the scale used was 2 that emotional intelligence scale by 32 items and cinderella complex as much 23 scale items. The method of data analysis was done by using Karl Pearson Product Moment correlation using SPSS 16.0 for windows.

Form the results of the analysis show the level of emotional intelligence and tendency cinderella complex of students in the average category with percentage 55,55% to 73,33% and a emotional intellicence for tendency cinderella complex. Based on the results of data analysis using product moment correlation results obtained $r_{xy} = -0.627$ and $\text{sig} = 0.000 < 0.05$. this indicates that there is a significant negative correlate between emotional intelligence with tendency cinderella complex.
