Cinderella complex tendency is the tendency of women to a psychic who depend on the show with a strong desire to maintain and protect other people and especially men of luarlah keyakinan that something that would help him. This study aims to determine the relationship between self-esteem with a tendency on the student semester Cinderella complex VI (six) psychology faculty UIN Malang Maulana Malik Ibrahim.

Methods now play used in this study is quantitative. This study uses a sample population, the subject is a student of the semester period of 2012 VI School of Psychology State Islamic University Malang Maulana Malik Ibrahim totaled 108 people. The data was collected with a Likert scale. Correlation analysis of research data using product moment, first tested the assumption that includes tests of normality and linearity, the data analysis performed using SPSS 16.0 for windows.

Based on the analysis level of Self Esteem School Psychology Student Semester VI UIN Malang Maliki While the majority of the level of 64,8%, while the Cinderella complex VI Semester Faculty of Psychology Student UIN Malang Maliki that the majority of the categories was 60,2%.

Testing the hypothesis in this study there is a significant negative relationship between Self Esteem with a tendency Cinderella complex. (r_{xy}) = -0394, the probability $p = 0.044 < 0.050$), thus providing sumbangsi Self esteem of 32.1% effective against the tendency cinderella complex at the Faculty of Psychology VI Semester Student UIN Malang Maliki, while the remaining amount of 67.9% determined by Another factor that is not expressed in this research.
