The success of social needs in social adjustment is related to social support from family, especially parents. Hurlock said that to guarantee their children doing good social adjustment, they give good opportunity to the children to have social contact with other children, and try to motivate them to be socially active in order to gain good social adjustment. Parents are a lot contribute to give social support to their children, even when they are far away separated.

The purposes of this research are (1) to discover parents' social support level of MAN Malang 1 accelerated students. (2) to discover social adjustment level of MAN Malang 1 accelerated students. (3) to discover relationship between parents' social support and social adjustment of Malang 1 accelerated students.

The research use quantitative-correlational method. The free variable of the research is parents' social support. The bound variable is social adjustment. The subject of the research is 42 accelerated students of MAN Malang 1.

The result of this research reveals that in the variable of parents' social support; 66,6% of students have high score, 30,9% of students have average score, 2,5% of students have low score. In the variable of social adjustment, 69% of students have high score, 28,5% of student have average score, 2,5% of students have low score.

The analysis says that the correlation between parents' social support and social adjustment is N=42, the correlation score is 0,433, meaning that both variable is in sufficient coefficient correlation category. Then, the significant score is 0.004 where it is \leq 0.05, meaning that there is significant relationship between parents' social support and social adjustment.
