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ABSTRACT

Assertive illocutionary acts is important because they are used to find out the meaning of someone's utterance or the speaker's intention to demonstrate a defense of truth. Furthermore, it can build effective communication because it allows individuals to respond appropriately to the speaker's intention like agree or disagree. The present research aims to identify the types of assertive illocutionary acts produced by Hailey Bieber which are included in the Call Her Daddy podcast. Qualitative descriptive method is used to analyze the data. This research used the theory proposed by Searle (1969) because the theory accommodates types of assertive illocutionary acts such as stating, informing, denying, affirming, boasting and complaining which has not been developed by other theories. Additionally assertive illocutionary acts is used to know how famous people respond to hate comments by defending the truth about what they say that can influence people. The present research indicate that there are several types of assertive illocutionary acts produced by Hailey Bieber such as stating 16 data, denying 4 data and informing 2 data with a total of 22 data.

This research is similar to previous studies that found assertive types but not all types were found. Their finding is varied, such as Abdullah, Muhammad (2021) who only found stating, informing and complaining types because he used the Korean English man YouTube channel as the research object. Meanwhile, Indrawati et al (2021) found the type of informing, stating, denying, and complaining because they used local guides as research objects. Apart from that, Sianipar (2022) found stating, informing and affirming types because she used Instagram and Twitter as research objects. Yulistiana F & Widyastuti (2022) found the stating, denying, informing and complaining types because they used Joe Bidden's speech about the first presidential debate as the research object. As for Kusumah, Febriant Argadie et al (2022) found stating, informing, and denying because they used a YouTube video entitled Similarities between Christianity and Islam by Dr Zakir Naik. Meanwhile, in this research, using the Call Her Daddy podcast as the research object found three types of assertive illocutionary acts such as stating, informing and denying. This research is in contrast with Zafirah et al (2019), Nono & Prayudha (2022), Sitorus et al (2022), Dwi Ummi, et al (2022), Hutajulu & Herman (2019), Fitriani, & Rasmita (2020), Thalia, Namira (2021), Ratri & Bram (2022), Prastio et al (2020), Aurelia (2022) they found several types of illocutionary acts, such as assertive, directive, expressive, commissive, declarative, and the most dominant is assertive illocutionary acts. Whereas in this research the researcher found several types of assertive illocutionary acts such as stating, informing, denying and the most dominant type is stating. The researcher cannot explain assertive types completely because researchers cannot find affirming, boasting, and complaining types in the Call Her Daddy podcast.

The limitation of this research is that researcher could not find three types of assertive illocutionary acts such as affirming, boasting and complaining. Therefore, the researcher suggests to the future researchers to use other objects, especially news reporters so that they can find five types of assertive illocutionary acts such as stating, informing, denying, affirming, boasting and complaining. The present research which was expected to provide understanding and increase knowledge of the readers about assertive illocutionary acts and how it is analyzed has been achieved.

Tindak ilokusi asertif penting dilakukan karena digunakan untuk mengetahui makna ujaran seseorang atau maksud penutur untuk menunjukkan pembelaan kebenaran. Lebih jauh lagi, dapat membangun komunikasi yang efektif karena memungkinkan individu memberikan respon yang tepat terhadap maksud pembicara seperti setuju atau tidak setuju. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengidentifikasi jenis tindak ilokusi asertif yang dihasilkan oleh Hailey Bieber yang terdapat dalam podcast Call Her Daddy. Metode deskriptif kualitatif digunakan untuk menganalisis data. Penelitian ini menggunakan teori yang dikemukakan oleh Searle (1969) karena teori tersebut mengakomodasi jenis tindak ilokusi asertif seperti menyatakan, memberi informasi, menyangkal, menegaskan, menyombongkan diri, dan mengeluh yang belum dikembangkan oleh teori lain. Selain itu tindak ilokusi asertif digunakan untuk mengetahui bagaimana orang terkenal menanggapi komentar kebencian dengan mempertahankan kebenaran tentang apa yang mereka katakan yang dapat mempengaruhi orang. Penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa ada beberapa jenis tindak ilokusi asertif yang dihasilkan oleh Hailey Bieber seperti menyatakan 16 data, menyangkal 4 data dan menginformasikan 2 data dengan jumlah 22 data.

Penelitian ini serupa dengan penelitian sebelumnya yang menemukan tipe asertif namun tidak semua tipe ditemukan. Temuan mereka beragam, seperti Abdullah, Muhammad (2021) yang hanya menemukan tipe-tipe yang menyatakan, menginformasikan, dan mengeluh karena menggunakan saluran YouTube pria Korea-Inggris sebagai objek penelitian. Sedangkan Indrawati dkk (2021) menemukan tipe menginformasikan, menyatakan, menyangkal, dan mengeluh karena menggunakan pemandu lokal sebagai objek penelitian. Selain itu, Sianipar (2022) menemukan tipe-tipe yang menyatakan, menginformasikan dan mengafirmasi karena menggunakan Instagram dan Twitter sebagai objek penelitian. Yulistiana F & Widyastuti (2022) menemukan tipe-tipe yang menyatakan, menyangkal, menginformasikan dan mengeluh karena menggunakan pidato Joe Bidden tentang debat capres pertama sebagai objek penelitian. Sedangkan untuk Kusumah, Febriant Argadie dkk (2022) menemukan adanya pernyataan, informasi, dan penyangkalan karena menggunakan video YouTube berjudul Persamaan Kristen dan Islam karya Dr Zakir Naik. Sedangkan pada penelitian ini dengan menggunakan podcast Call Her Daddy sebagai objek penelitian ditemukan tiga jenis tindak ilokusi asertif yaitu menyatakan, memberi informasi, dan menyangkal. Penelitian ini berbeda dengan Zafirah dkk (2019), Nono & Prayudha (2022), Sitorus dkk (2022), Dwi Ummi, dkk (2022), Hutajulu & Herman (2019), Fitriani, & Rasmita (2020), Thalia, Namira (2021), Ratri & Bram (2022), Prastio dkk (2020), Aurelia (2022) menemukan beberapa jenis tindak ilokusi seperti asertif, direktif, ekspresif, komisif, deklaratif, dan yang paling dominan adalah tindak ilokusi asertif. Sedangkan dalam penelitian ini peneliti menemukan beberapa jenis tindak ilokusi asertif seperti menyatakan, memberitahukan, menyangkal dan jenis yang paling dominan adalah menyatakan. Peneliti tidak dapat menjelaskan tipe asertif secara lengkap karena peneliti tidak dapat menemukan tipe afirmasi, membual, dan mengeluh dalam podcast Call Her Daddy.

Keterbatasan penelitian ini adalah peneliti tidak dapat menemukan tiga jenis tindak ilokusi asertif seperti menegaskan, membual, dan mengeluh. Oleh karena itu, peneliti menyarankan kepada peneliti selanjutnya untuk menggunakan objek lain khususnya wartawan berita sehingga dapat menemukan lima jenis tindak ilokusi asertif seperti menyatakan, menginformasikan, menyangkal, menegaskan, membual dan mengeluh. Penelitian yang diharapkan dapat memberikan pemahaman dan menambah pengetahuan pembaca tentang tindak ilokusi asertif dan cara menganalisisnya telah tercapai.

مستخلص البحث

تعد الأفعال التلفظية الحازمة مهمة لأنها تستخدم لمعرفة معنى كلام شخص ما أو نية المتحدث لإظهار الدفاع عن الحقيقة. علاوة على ذلك، يمكنه بناء تواصل فعال لأنه يسمح للأفراد بالاستجابة بشكل مناسب لنية المتحدث مثل الموافقة أو عدم الموافقة. يهدف البحث الحالي إلى التعرف على أنواع الأفعال الإلقاءية الحازمة التي تنتجها هيلي بيبر والتي تم تضمينها في البودكاست Call Her Daddy. ويستخدم المنهج الوصفي النوعي لتحليل البيانات. استخدم هذا البحث النظرية التي اقترحها سيرل (1969) لأن النظرية تستوعب أنواعاً من الأفعال الجزمية مثل القول والإخبار والإنكار والتأكيد والتباهي والشكوى والتي لم تطورها نظريات أخرى. بالإضافة إلى ذلك، يتم استخدام الأفعال الإلقاءية الحازمة لمعرفة كيفية استجابة الأشخاص المشهورين للتعليقات التي تحض على الكراهية من خلال الدفاع عن حقيقة ما يقولونه والذي يمكن أن يؤثر على الأشخاص. ويشير البحث الحالي إلى أن هناك عدة أنواع من الأفعال الإلقاءية الحازمة التي تنتجها هيلي بيبر مثل ذكر ١٦ بيانات ونفي ٤ بيانات وأبلغ عن ٢ بيانات بإجمالي 22 بيانات.

يشبه هذا البحث الدراسات السابقة التي وجدت أنواعاً حازمة ولكن لم يتم العثور على جميع الأنواع. وتنوعت نتائجهم، مثل عبد الله، محمد (٢٠٢١) الذي لم يجد سوى أنواع التصريح والإبلاغ والشكوى لأنه استخدم قناة اليوتيوب للرجل الإنجليزي الكوري كموضوع للبحث. وفي الوقت نفسه، وجد إندراواتي وآخرون (٢٠٢١) نوع الإبلاغ والتصريح والإنكار والشكوى لأنهم استخدموا أدلة محلية كاشياء بحثية. وبصرف النظر عن ذلك، وجدت سيانيبار (٢٠٢٢) أنواعاً تفيد وتخبر وتؤكد لأنها استخدمت استراتيجيات توبيخ كاشياء بحثية. وجدت يوليسيتيانا إف ويدياستوتي (٢٠٢٢) أنواع التصريح والإنكار والإبلاغ والشكوى لأنهم استخدموا خطاب جو بايدن حول المناظرة الرئاسية الأولى كموضوع بحث. أما كوسومة، فقد وجد فييريانت أرغادي وآخرون (٢٠٢٢) قولاً وإخباراً وإنكاراً لأنهم استخدموا مقطع فيديو على اليوتيوب بعنوان أوجه التشابه بين المسيحية والإسلام للدكتور ذاكر نايك. وفي الوقت نفسه، في هذا البحث، باستخدام بودكاست Call Her Daddy كموضوع بحثي، وجد ثلاثة أنواع من الأفعال الإلقاءية الحازمة مثل القول والإبلاغ والإنكار. يتناقض هذا البحث زافرة (٢٠١٩)، نونو وفرايودا (٢٠٢٢)، سيتوروس وآخرون (٢٠٢٢)، دوي أمي وآخرون (٢٠٢٢)، هوتاجولو وهيرمان (٢٠١٩)، فطرياني وراسميئا (٢٠٢٠)، تاليا ونميرا (٢٠٢١)، راتري وبرام (٢٠٢٢)، براستيو وآخرون (٢٠٢٠)، أوريليا (٢٠٢٢) وجدوا عدة أنواع من الأفعال التلفظية، مثل الأفعال الجزمية، والتوجيهية، والتعبيرية، والتوصية، والتصريحية، والأكثر هيمنة هي الأفعال التأكيدية. حيث وجد الباحث في هذا البحث عدة أنواع من الأفعال الجزمية مثل القول والإخبار والإنكار والنوع الغالب هو القول. لا يستطيع الباحث شرح الأنواع الحازمة بشكل كامل لأنه لا يمكن للباحثين العثور على أنواع مؤكدة ومتفخرة ومتدمرة في البودكاست Call Her Daddy

و محدودة هذا البحث هي أن الباحثة لم تتمكن من العثور على ثلاثة أنواع من الأفعال التلفظية التوكيدية مثل التوكيد والتباهي والشكوى. ولذلك تقترح الباحثة على الباحثين المستقبليين استخدام كائنات أخرى، وخاصة مراسلي الأخبار، حتى يتمكنوا من العثور على خمسة أنواع من الأفعال الجزمية مثل القول والإبلاغ والإنكار والتأكيد والتباهي والشكوى. لقد تم تحقيق هذا البحث الذي كان من المتوقع أن يوفر فهماً وزيادة معرفة القراء حول الأفعال التلفظية الجزمية وكيفية تحليلها

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CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

This chapter discusses background of the study, problem of the study, significance, scope and limitation, and definition of key terms.

A. Background of the Study

Everyone has different thoughts, so they have different opinions which are often described as a form of expression from one person to another. Someone can express their opinion through speech to show something to others. To express themselves, humans produce utterances that contain phrases and show movement through these utterances. Speech is a form of language that contains a combination of words and aims to express a certain meaning. Meanwhile, speech acts refer to the ability of speakers to use language in various contexts (Chaer & Agustina 2004: 49-50). So that the relationship between the two is a combination of someone's words and utterances that contain certain meanings and actions. Statements, promises, offers, questions, and other similar expressions are all considered illocutionary acts in Searle's theory. Illocutionary acts aim to say and do something, and the act of doing something is another name for the illocutionary act.

Speech act is one of the pragmatic studies that examines the meaning of the speaker's language which contains an action. Speech act connects the speaker and the speech partner or the writer and the reader and something being talked about. Speech act is the study of appropriate and correct ways of interacting or

communicating so that the interlocutor can easily understand the intent and message of the conversation. According to Yule (2006) actions carried out through an utterance are called speech acts. Speaking in a language involves performing speech acts, including giving orders, asking questions, making promises, and making statements (Searle, 1969).

Pragmatics is a branch of linguistics that studies the use of language regarding its context. Pragmatics is a branch of linguistics concerned with the use of language (Levinson, 1983). Pragmatic functions emphasize the function of language in everyday communication. A speaker must be able to choose and use the correct language so that the listener can understand the meaning of an utterance. Furthermore, by studying pragmatics one can understand people's meanings, their assumptions, their intentions or goals, and the types of actions they show when speaking.

The primary purpose of the illocutionary acts is for the listener to understand the speaker's utterances. Making statements, offers, promises, and others in the form of speech and expressed directly by using certain expressions is an illocutionary act (Levinson in Cahyono, 1995: 224). In addition, illocutionary acts reveal and provide information. On the other hand, illocutionary act refers to the use of language to convey a confident attitude. According to Wijaya (1996: 18-19), illocutionary acts are defined as speech acts that have meaning and utterances and are designed to inform and influence other people.

In addition, the present research discusses the utterances of Hailey Bieber, daughter of Stephen Baldwin and Kennya Baldwin, Hailey Rhode Bieber or known as Hailey Bieber. She was born on November 22, 1996 and started her professional life as a model for ORD NY Storm London agency. In 2018, she married the famous Canadian musician and songwriter Justin Bieber. In 2022, Hailey Bieber received a lot of criticism from netizens regarding this, she was invited to one of the famous podcasts, namely the Call Her Daddy podcast, which gave her space to respond to the hate speech directed at her. Since she is a public figure, her behavior has the potential to be a role model for many people. Therefore, it is very important to analyze how she responds and defends the truth of what she says in fighting hate speech. Further such a case can be analyzed by using illocutionary acts especially the assertive one.

Several previous studies discussed assertive illocutionary acts and illocutionary acts that have some similarities with the present research. First, Zafirah et al (2019), found that 481 statements from the talks of Nouman Ali Khan. According to the statement, Nouman used four illocutionary acts in his speech: representative, directive, commissive and expressive. Furthermore, Kusumah, Febriant Argadie et al (2021) found there are two forms of assertive illocutionary speaking actions: stating and informing. Similarly, Yulia, Fania & Widyastuti (2022), found that Joe Biden's interruption has all the features of assertive illocutionary action embodied in his speech. Furthermore, Dwi Umami, et al (2022) found that there are several types of assertive speech acts, including informing, stating, and affirming.

In addition, Hutajulu & Herman (2019) found in the research findings, which included qualitative and quantitative methods. The characters make about 216 different utterances, which the researchers can identify. Similarly, Fitriani, & Rasmita (2020) found that only four of the five types of illocutionary actions that are representative, directive, expressive, and commissive are identified in the context of film. Furthermore, Thalia, Namira (2021) found 61 utterances were made using characters containing a wide variety and characteristics of illocutionary act. In addition, Ratri & Bram (2022), found that film characters used all illocutionary actions. The assertive form of the illocutionary act appears as the most common, occurring 13 times.

In addition, Prastio et al (2020) found that ADJT used three different categories of speech acts, including directive speech acts with prohibiting, ordering, and asking. Furthermore, Indriwati, et al (2021) found that the Assertive Illocutionary Acts Used by Local Guides in Tirta Empul Temple uses four kinds of assertive: informing, stating, expressing opinions, and reminding. In addition, Aurelia (2022) found that there are four different categories of illocutionary actions: assertive, directive, expressive, and commissive.

In addition, Abdullah, Muhammad (2021), found that based on data, Beckham and Heung-Min used 38 assertive speech acts in the video. Similarly, Nono & Prayudha (2022) found two types of assertive, directive, and expressive illocutionary acts were discovered by researchers. Furthermore, Sianipar (2022) found how widely assertive illocutionary behaviors are available and used on social media platforms such as Instagram and Twitter. In addition, Sitorus et al

(2022) found that Sandiaga Uno used five different forms of illocutionary acts in the podcast and found four types: assertive, directive, commissive, expressive, and declarative.

The present research is different from previous research because this research examines assertive illocutionary acts in the Call Her Daddy podcast which focuses on Hailey Bieber's utterances using the theory put forward by Searle (1969). The present research wants to know how Hailey Bieber considering utterances from netizens in the form of hate comments therefore this research wants to examine Hailey Bieber's perception of these utterances with a focus on analyzing assertive illocutionary acts using Searle's (1969) theory. This research has linguistic reasons that is a statement spoken about something, thus the utterances in this research discusses hate comment directed at someone famous, namely Hailey Bieber. Several previous studies also analyzed assertive illocutionary acts in pragmatic studies but used different theories and data. The researcher uses Searle's (1969) theory because Searle's (1969) theory provides a more detailed and in-depth explanation about assertive illocutionary acts than other theory. However the previous studies above have not considered the kinds of assertive illocutionary acts.

Searle's theory is one of the linguistic theories that can be used to define assertive illocutionary acts in the present research. Before discussing illocutionary acts, Searle was one of Austin's students who developed in depth the illocutionary acts proposed by Austin (1962: 150). Searle categorizes illocutionary acts to make it easier for people to identify illocutionary acts with five categories namely

assertive, commissive, directive, expressive and declarative. The present research focus on assertive illocutionary acts and types of speech acts such as asserting, informing, declaring, claiming, and other similar expressions that bind the speaker to the truth of the ideas being communicated, according to Searle (1969). In general, the present research seeks assertive illocutionary acts in various ways to convey meaning in utterances so that the readers understand the meaning of the utterances being conveyed. The Call Her Daddy podcast is a podcast channel that is famous for its interviews with Hollywood celebrities so that conveying the meaning of assertive illocutionary acts can be easily understood globally. This research also complements previous research by providing new insights into Hailey Bieber's use of assertive illocutionary acts in the Call Her Daddy podcast. The differences in topics on objects are of particular value in this research. It also fills the gap between previous research and this research.

The similarity of this research with previous research is that both analyze in pragmatic studies and also several studies using the same theory, namely the theory of Searle (1969) which analyzes one type of illocutionary act, namely assertive illocutionary act. In addition, the similarity of this research with previous research is that they both use a qualitative descriptive approach. Some of their research also discusses assertive illocutionary acts in which there are several types of assertive illocutionary acts such as stating, informing, refusing and so on.

B. Problems of the Study

Based on the background of the present research, researcher has formulated several questions such as:

1. What are the types of assertive illocutionary acts used in the Hailey Bieber's utterance?
2. How are the assertive illocutionary acts performed by the Hailey Bieber's utterance?

C. Significance of the Study

Practically, to provides information about the analysis of one type of illocutionary act, namely assertive illocutionary act, using the theory of Searle (1969). Searle states that he tries to communicate something based on truth (statements, descriptions, and predictions). Furthermore, to help readers understand the meaning of Hailey Bieber's utterances in linguistic studies, this study observes speech acts that only focus on assertive illocutionary acts.

The present research tries to provide understanding and increase knowledge for readers about the meaning of assertive illocutionary acts and what assertive illocutionary acts are obtained to find out the meaning behind research on Hailey Bieber's utterances. In addition, it helps readers understand certain utterances conveyed in linguistic studies that focus on pragmatic domains and also becomes a reference for students, teachers and other readers to become more familiar with assertive illocutionary acts. Especially assertive illocutionary acts in this study on the Call Her Daddy podcast, which only focuses on Hailey Bieber's utterances.

D. Scope and Limitation

The present research focuses on pragmatic studies that discuss the meaning presented by the speaker. Someone who expresses something in the form of sentences and sayings can have meaning (Yule, 1996). The scope of this research

is the theory of Searle (1969) which explains assertive illocutionary acts and aims to analyze speech acts in a pragmatic study that focuses on Hailey Bieber's utterances.

The limitation of this research is the analysis of assertive illocutionary acts expressed by Hailey Bieber. Assertive are statements of fact because they try to describe a situation. This statement can be evaluated as true or false. This analysis refers to the subject of the Call Her Daddy podcast created by Alexandra Cooper and Sofia Franklyn in 2018. This podcast is an interview podcasts available on the YouTube platform.

E. Definition of Key Terms

Here are the definitions of key terms in the present research, such as:

1. Pragmatics is the study of the ability of language users to produce sentences with appropriate conditions.
2. Speech acts is act that performed or conveyed through utterances of Hailey Bieber that focus on assertive illocutionary acts.
3. Illocutionary act is a speech act to do something with the intention conveyed by Hailey Bieber which has a specific purpose.
4. Assertive is a type of illocutionary act that contains a statement of fact that trying to describe the actual situation.
5. Podcast is the object of the present research to analyze Hailey Bieber's utterances. Call Her Daddy podcast is one of some available podcasts on the YouTube platform.

CHAPTER II

REVIEW OF RELATED LITERATURE

This chapter provides a review of some relevant literature. Pragmatics, speech acts, assertive illocutionary acts, types of assertive illocutionary acts and language Properties in English Podcast. This research uses Searle's (1969) theory about assertive illocutionary acts.

A. Pragmatics

Pragmatics is a branch of linguistics that studies the use of language concerning its context. According to Yule (2014: 5), The study of the relationship between language and language users is known as pragmatics. Furthermore, Cleopatra & Dalimunthe (2016: 3) also argue that one of the linguistic sciences called pragmatics examines how to speak correctly and productively. The speaker plays an essential role in helping the listener understand what is being said. Pragmatics can also be interpreted as a condition that determines whether the use of language is harmonious or not in the communication aspect of language use or external language contexts involving the meaning of utterances (Kridalaksana, 1993, p. 177). Pragmatics is known as a study that examines the meaning of speakers, language and language structure.

According to Rahardi (2019:28), Pragmatics belongs to the linguistics department, which deals with meaning. The meaning in question is the speaker's meaning. The speaker can also persuade the listener to be interested in the discussed topic. Pragmatics not only investigates all aspects of language but also

aspects outside of language. Pragmatics is the study of the ability of language users to associate sentences with appropriate context. The branch of linguistics known as pragmatics studies how language is used (Levinson, 1983). The relationship between the speaker and listener codes is known as pragmatics (Rahman, 2019). Moreover, according to Verhaar (1996:14), Pragmatics is a branch of linguistics that studies language structure and communication between speakers and listeners. Furthermore, pragmatics is used as a sign of language on the topic under discussion. Pragmatics explores the relationship between language and the meaning of utterances. The use of language in pragmatics is very important because pragmatics is a branch of linguistics that studies the use of language properly and correctly.

B. Speech Acts

The use of language as a tool for action is called speech acts. All words or phrases created by the speaker have some communicative purpose. The speaker's language ability in the face of certain conditions determines the act of speech. This is more evident in speech acts when considering utterance based meaning of an activity. Austin claims that when someone says something, they also do something. Yule in Wiyatasari (2015:46), the phrase speech act is an action conveyed through speech used as another definition of the term. Speech acts occur in social settings that set the stage for various speech choices. Speech community activities, speech situations, speech events, and activities after discussing speech acts are just some things that must be understood in the speech setting, especially the meaning of speech acts.

In addition, according to Tarigan (2015), speech acts are one type of language that is very important for humans, especially in terms of communication. Austin also states that many ways to say something are to do something, we can say something and act on it, or even say anything and act on it. Speaking in a language involves performing speech acts, including giving orders, asking questions, making promises, and making statements (Searle, 1969). Further, Austin believes that each utterance contains three actions, each with its unique power. He also classified speech acts as locutions, illocution, or perlocutions. In addition, according to Chaer and Leonie (2010:50) speech acts are defined as individual psychological phenomena determined by the speaker's language ability in the face of certain situations. It can be concluded that speech act has an important role in human life because speech act examines someone's speech which contains a certain meaning.

Austin divides speech acts into three types, namely: locutionary, illocutionary and perlocutionary:

1. Locutionary Act

Locutionary act is one type of speech act used to convey something in the form of sentences that are meaningful and understandable. According to Austin that locutionary is the act of conveying something, providing information, speaking, asking, and others. Locutionary speech acts are utterances in a word or sentence according to the intended meaning. The term "I'm starving" is only meant to let the other person know that the speaker is hungry at the time of making what he said and that it has no other meaning.

In addition, Locutionary act is also interpreted as a speech act to express something by using words or sentences that have meaning. (Gunarwan in Rustono, 1999: 37). According to Searle (1969), locutionary acts are speech acts that use words, phrases and sentences in accordance with the meaning contained in these words, phrases and sentences. In locutionary acts, stating something to others is only for the purpose of informing and has no other purpose, for example: "It's time to collect the exam at the end of next week". The teacher informs that the final exam collection is next week.

2. Illocutionary Act

Illocutionary acts refer to someone's behavior or speech that has a specific purpose. One can describe this type of speech act as "The act of doing something". The phrase "I'm hungry" is not only intended to tell the speech partner that the speaker is experiencing hunger when speaking, but the speaker asks the speech partner to do something related to the speaker's hunger, such as giving or taking food. This action is not only to express something, but also to ask the speech partner to do something.

Meanwhile, according to Rahardi, an illocutionary act is any utterance uttered while speaking that contains the correct meaning with a specific purpose. (Rahardi, 2005: 17). Illocutionary act is acting by saying something. In an illocutionary speech act, the speaker says something while using discriminating power, which causes the speaker to act based on what he said. This action has a meaning related to social functions. Wijaya (1996: 18-19) defines illocutionary acts as speech acts that have a purpose and function as utterances to involve the

meaning of speech. The act of ordering someone to do something is known as illocutionary action. For example: "The final exam will be held next week". In the example, the teacher states that the exam will be held next week and asks students to prepare by studying hard.

3. Perlocutionary Act

Perlocutionary act is a verbal action that has an impact on the listener, this statement is known as an act of influencing someone. For example, "my hands itch" could indicate it is affecting someone else. According to Austin, the perlocutionary act is what we do by saying anything, such as stating, informing, claiming and others. thus, perlocutionary acts must be seen as a causal relationship between two events where the speaker's speech has a specific purpose.

In addition, the utterances spoken by speakers often affect listeners or interlocutors. The effect of saying something is what Austin (1962: 101) calls perlocutionary. Speakers' utterances in perlocutionary acts can be intentional or unintentional. Speech acts that influence speech partners are called perlocutionary acts. Perlocutionary speech act is an attempt to achieve something by saying something. For example: "Your grades on the finals were very good." In this example the teacher gives praise that the student's grades are good so that students improve their learning.

C. Assertive Illocutionary Acts Theories

Assertive are statements of fact to describe certain situations.

According to Leech (1993:327), using certain verbs that connect speakers with

the truth of their statements can function as evidence of assertive illocutionary actions. Usually, the utterances refer to the speaker and the speaker's statements are used as affirmations, predictions, announcements, and so on. This verb often appears in communication between the speaker and the interlocutor in certain situations.

Meanwhile, the speaker's assertive illocutionary act defends the truth of what he says, according to Searle (1969). According to Searle (1969), assertive illocutionary acts include statements, suggestions, boasts, complaints, and claims that bind the speaker to the truth of the argument. Such a statement might be something like, "My cat ran out into the yard." The information in the speech shows that the speaker is obliged to the truth of the utterance, thus making it a symbolic or assertive illocutionary act. The speaker is responsible for ensuring that his speech is accurate and that it is true that the cat enters the yard.

According to Searle (1969), there are five different types of illocutionary acts: Assertive, directive, commissive, expressive, declarative.

1. Assertive

Speech acts related to saying something are called assertive illocutionary acts. With this statement, the speaker relates to the truth of what is said. When someone wants to say something, give an opinion, confirm, report, or make a suggestion, they usually use this speech act. Examples are "Nothing can make me happy" and "Rain is pouring". In addition, according to Searle (1969), assertive illocutionary acts include statements, suggestions, boasts, complaints,

and claims that bind the speaker to the truth of the argument.

Representative or assertive illocutionary acts are speech acts that bring the speaker closer to the truth that is shown or expressed through utterances. This type of speech act expresses the beliefs of the speaker. These words include stating, concluding, reporting, claiming, demanding, complaining, and expressing opinions.

1. Directive

Directive illocutionary act is a term used to describe utterances that aim at commanding, begging, advising, recommending and other similar actions on the part of the speaker. An example would be "Will you help me?" and "Please don't leave me." Furthermore, according to Searle (1969), illocutionary acts are speech acts such as ordering, asking, and advising, advising which are intended to persuade the listener to act.

Directive illocutionary acts in this type of speech act, the speaker instructs the speech partner to do something based on what the speaker said. This type of speech act expresses the speaker's desire to do something. The speaker intends to use it to achieve some purpose of the action. Examples are suggestions, orders, questions, requests, quotes, and orders.

2. Commissive

Commissive illocutionary acts, such as making promises or offers and swearing, are expressions of promises or offers. Examples are "I will come to your place on Sunday" and "I will come back next year."

In addition, according to Searle (1962), commissive is a type of speech

that is used to express promises or offers, such as promising, swearing, and offering something. A commissive illocutionary act is a speech act that encourages the speaker to act. This type of speech act expresses the intention of the speaker to do something.

3. Expressive

Expressive illocutionary acts are speech acts in which speakers express psychological actions or statements in joy, like or dislike, or sadness. A speaker can use expressive illocutionary acts, such as thanking, apologizing, praising, and expressing condolences, to convey or show his psychological attitude towards certain scenarios.

In addition, according to Searle (1969), expressive illocutionary acts are types of utterances used to express or show the speaker's psychological attitude towards a situation, such as thanking, congratulating, forgiving, blaming, praising, or condolences. Examples include "Thanks for taking care of my cat" and "You look amazing today!".

4. Declarative

Declarative is a type of speech that refers to something real or an ongoing reality, such as resignation, dismissal, name, punishment, and so on. Furthermore, according to Searle (1969), declarative illocutionary acts, such as resignation, dismissal, baptism, name, period, ostracism, and punishment, are forms of speech that relate speech content to reality.

Declarative illocutionary act is a type of speech act to influence and change the circumstances of a certain event that is happening at that time. This speech

act is usually conveyed by a certain party, for example a party representing an institution. As a result, this type of speech act is an institutionalized performative act. For example, "You were fired from my office", "It's so cold",

In addition, assertive illocutionary acts divided into six types by Searle (1969), including:

1. Stating

This type of assertive illocutionary act is used to express the meaning of something. By declaring, a person conveys knowledge to others. When a speaker conveys understanding to the other person, they automatically state it. Examples are "The ball is round" and "The water is fast". The function of this type of assertive illocutionary act is utterances or expressions used to provide information or inform something to other people.

2. Informing

In this type of speech act, the speaker provides information through utterances, but this type is only used when the other person does not know the information. For example: "graduation will be held online". The function of this type of speech is to inform other people about things that are not yet known by the speech partner.

3. Affirming

This type of assertive illocutionary act includes specific affirmations with positive rather negative statements. "He said he lied in a letter to his brother in Mecca," for example.

4. Boasting

This illocutionary act is used by speakers to convey a sense of pride. This illocutionary act is considered unfriendly and rude. For example, "I am the most attractive girl in school." The function of arrogant speech is to express a sense of pride through utterances or expressions. This speech is included in the category of impolite speech.

5. Complaining

This illocutionary act contains a complaint or is used to lament about something. Examples are "I'm thirsty" and "I can't run." The purpose of utterances of lamentation is to express feelings of sadness due to suffering, pain, disappointment, and so on.

6. Denying

This illocutionary act is used to deny something. For example, "I can't go anywhere without you," or "I can't do it alone." The function of this type of speech act is to reject something from someone else.

D. Language Properties in English Podcast

Podcasts are audio broadcasts attached to the web or some other apps and platforms. The definition of a podcast is actually taken from an iPod and broadcast. Pods are taken from Apple's digital media player 'iPod' and casts are taken from radio 'broadcast'. Podcasts can be listened to anywhere and anytime. Call her daddy is a popular podcast in New York, United States. This podcast is included in the podcast interview category where this podcast is hosted by one host and one guest star who is interviewed. The content or topic of the podcast

usually depends on the guest stars who are invited or usually also discuss topics that are currently viral so that the podcast is interesting to watch or listen to.

The researcher observes the language characteristics found in foreign podcasts such as the podcasts mentioned above. In this podcast, the podcaster or host and guest star or someone being interviewed tends to use non-formal or everyday language in order to be able to communicate casually and freely. Not only do foreign podcasts use non-formal language, several podcasts in Indonesia also often use everyday language and sometimes also use modern language or can also be called slang, such as bucin, baper, special committee and others. However, Maulana (2022) states that when presenting a podcast, use language that is more informative, clear, concise and interactive with the sources. The host or podcaster must have soft skills such as interview skills, public speaking and others. It can make communication more interesting and guests won't feel bored.

CHAPTER III

RESEARCH METHOD

This chapter discusses the method used by the researcher to get the data. In addition, she also tries to provide an explanation of the strategies used by researcher to collect and research data. This chapter contains research design, research instrument, data collection and data analysis.

A. Research Design

In the present research, the researcher used descriptive qualitative research methods to analyze the data. In general, qualitative descriptive research methods describe qualitative data in detail. This research combines qualitative and descriptive research methods and is often used to examine social phenomena, situations, and other matters. According to Moleong (2016: 6), qualitative research aims to understand phenomena such as behavior, perceptions, motivations, actions, and others experienced by research subjects. Qualitative research is very different from quantitative research because quantitative research is research that can be counted, measured and compared with a scale of numbers. While qualitative research is descriptive research related to meaning.

The researcher used the study text method because the researcher analyzed the transcript of the dialogue between the podcast host and guest star Hailey Bieber contained in the Call Her Daddy podcast sourced from the You Tube Platform. Text study is one of the methods contained in qualitative research studies that analyze written materials based on their context. Written materials can be in the form of textbooks, magazines, newspapers, manuscripts, articles, letters

and so on. This research analyzed the data in detail in terms of content, meaning and structure. According to Lockyer (in Given 2008: 865) the intended text is not only in the form of written narratives taken from newspapers, magazines, TV shows, speech scripts, but also extends to architecture, clothing models, even household furniture, offices, restaurants and other facilities - facilities in public spaces.

B. Research Instrument

Since the research used a qualitative descriptive method, the research instrument used to collect data is the researcher herself. Research instruments are tools used to collect research data to produce predictable results in the form of empirical data (Sanjaya, 2015). In the present research, the researcher collected data and analyzed it independently. There are several kinds of research instruments such as surveys, observations, interviews and so on. In this research, she used the observation method where the researcher conducted research by observing something that is used as the object of observation. The benefits of choosing the observation method are that it is easier and simpler.

C. Data and Data Source

Written data used in the present research because this research focuses on dialogue transcripts on the Call Her Daddy podcast which is available on YouTube. The data collected in the form of dialogue text or transcripts sourced from the podcast. The Call Her Daddy podcast is a source of research data in the form of Hailey Bieber's utterances which contain assertive illocutionary acts. On November 22, 1996, Hailey Rhode Bieber, better known by her stage name

Hailey Bieber, was born. She is the daughter of Kenny Baldwin and Stephen Baldwin.

Since 2014, Hailey started modeling and in 2018 she married Justin Bieber, a well-known musician. There are two types of data sources in the present research, namely primary data sources and secondary data sources. The Call Her Daddy podcast served as the main source of information for the research, and the subtitle transcripts served as a secondary data source. Several utterances expressed by Hailey Bieber can be classified as assertive illocutionary acts.

D. Data Collection

The researcher has several steps in collecting data. The first step she accessed the YouTube platform by using a computer. After entering the first page, she searched Call Her Daddy podcast channel in the search field. After that, she has been looking for Hailey Bieber's video interview, then the researcher collected all of her utterances by watching and listening carefully and then recorded the transcript of Hailey Bieber's utterances. The next step she read the transcripts and classified utterances containing assertive illocutionary acts using the theory chosen by the researcher, namely Searle's theory (1969). This is done to make it easier for readers to find various assertive illocutionary acts in the video. In the next step she played the video over and over to confirm what she heard and recorded it. The data source comes from a video transcript of a podcast on the YouTube platform that prioritizes Hailey Bieber's utterances. The

podcast recording took place on September 28, 2022, and has a broadcast time of 1:05:12.

E. Data Analysis

The researcher collected the data and analyzed it. She used Searle's theory to analyze assertive illocutionary acts. The researcher used several steps in analyzing the data and the first step she translated the results of the transcripts records into Indonesian because the transcripts records are in English text. The next step, she recorded the translation of the transcript, then she read it and classified it carefully which Hailey Bieber's utterances contained assertive illocutionary acts. Then she copied the results on her computer and added the results of her analysis to her proposal.

CHAPTER IV

FINDING AND DISCUSSION

The researcher explains her findings and discussion in this chapter. Besides that, she will also answer research questions regarding assertive illocutionary acts contained in the present research. Then, in the discussion, the researcher will develop an analysis on the findings using the theory of Searle (1969).

A. Finding

The data from the present research are the utterances of the guest star the Call Her Daddy podcast, Hailey Bieber. This podcast was created by Sofia Franklyn and Alexandra Cooper and hosted by her. The researcher found data from transcripts and subtitles on the Call Her Daddy podcast. The data in the form of utterance is converted into sentences through transcripts and subtitles in the video podcast. In this section, the researcher finds some data for each type of assertive illocutionary act and all data can be seen in the appendix.

1. Stating

Stating used to express the meaning of something. By declaring, someone is conveying something to someone else.

Datum 1

Alex: "So let's talk about your experience with there's been a lot of hate on the internet I know you don't like to talk about this stuff but you've never."

Hailey: **"It literally makes me so uncomfortable"**

Alex: "Yeah"

Hailey: **"I'm like I'm like can't stop moving And I'm like crawling because I just feel like there's like a little bit of that like anxiety of like people will probably take it the wrong way."**

Context of Datum 1

The conversation above was produced by two famous women, namely Alexandra Cooper as the host and Hailey Bieber as a guest star in a podcast created in 2018. The topic discussed in the conversation above is Hailey Bieber's experience of the many haters on the internet and taken from minute 21:37 to 21:49. They conducted an interview at the Call Her Daddy podcast studio in New York City, United States on September 28, 2022. Alex tried to talk about hate towards Hailey on the internet. Based on the conversation Hailey stated that she was really uncomfortable with her experience of having a lot of hate on the internet. She also stated that she could not stop moving because of the hate that exists on the internet. She had a bit of an anxious feeling like someone might take the wrong path.

Analysis of Datum 1

Hailey's statement above belongs to the assertive illocutionary acts type of stating because in that conversation Hailey stated that she felt uncomfortable because she had haters on the internet. According to Searle (1969) stating is used to express the meaning of something. By stating, a person conveys knowledge to others. Hailey conveyed what she really felt for Alex, as explained above, that she

felt uncomfortable with the treatment of people on social media and in the real world so that Hailey's utterance in the conversation above included in the assertive illocutionary acts of the stating type.

Datum 2

Alex: "In December of 2020 a person posted a video encouraging haters to comment on your Instagram live with nasty messages announcing their allegiance for Justin's ex and just like fully harassing you on your life what do you remember feeling on that Instagram live when you saw those comments start popping up."

Hailey: **" I don't well I think there's like a certain like almost like numbness that you get where you're just like you just know what's going to happen it still happens to this day this is you're talking about something that was two years ago now almost three and it's something that's if I was to go live on Instagram right now it would still be happening probably less which is nice but you just reach a point where you're just like you have to just like ignore it and be like okay."**

Context of Datum 2

The characters in the conversation above are still the same as the previous context, namely Alex and Hailey. The topic discussed in the conversation above is regarding the video of one hater that encourages other haters to comment on Hailey Bieber's live broadcast on his Instagram account and the conversation taken from minute 23:15 to 23:40. Apart from that, the time and place are the same, namely at the Call Her Daddy podcast studio, New York City and taken on September 28, 2022. According to the conversation Alex told Hailey that in December 2020 she found a video post inviting haters to comment with inappropriate or unkind messages on live broadcasts on Hailey's Instagram account. In addition, the haters also indirectly revealed that they were still loyal to Justin Bieber's ex-girlfriend and Alex thought that this was the same as harassing Hailey Bieber where Hailey is Justin's legal wife at this time. Then Hailey stated

that she felt like something was almost numb and she thinks one only knows what was going to happen that is still going to happen to this day. She also stated that Alex was talking about something that happened almost 3 years ago and Hailey thought even if Hailey went live on Instagram now maybe it would still happen but Hailey ignored that.

Analysis of Datum 2

Hailey's statement above belongs to the assertive illocutionary acts type of stating because in that conversation Hailey stated that she felt something was almost numb and according to her Alex was talking about something that happened almost 3 years ago and Hailey thought even if Hailey was airing on Instagram right now maybe it would still happen but Hailey would ignore it. According to Searle (1969) stating is used to express the meaning of something. By stating, a person conveys knowledge to others. Hailey told Alex that there was something she could barely feel and what Alex had talked about was an event that happened several years ago and if it happened now she would ignore it, therefore Hailey's utterance in the conversation above included in the assertive illocutionary acts of type stating.

Datum 3

Alex: "You are starting to share more and even in the video that you made where you basically asked people to stop harassing you and you're like leave me alone just leave me."

Hailey: **"I was like half joking but I was being half serious like it was supposed to be something that was like light and funny but I was also being serious because I like woke up one day and I was like I can't believe we're still doing this."**

Alex: "Because what you like read a comment."

Hailey: **"Yeah like I was I which again like I have to stop myself from doing all the time because we know that the internet is a toxic hole and like**

comments are a toxic hole but I was just like curious about something and then I'm like reading I'm like are we still talking about this like we're getting to this has been for it's been years now like four years we've been together like come on."

Context of Datum 3

In the data used by the researcher, there are 2 famous figures Alex and Hailey. The topic discussed in the conversation above was Hailey starting to open up in the video uploads she made and she also asked netizens to stop harassing her and the conversation taken from minute 29:49 to 30:16. They conducted an interview at the Podcast studio Call Her Daddy New York, USA on September 28, 2022. In this conversation, Alex revealed that Hailey had started sharing or was a little more open. Hailey even made a video asking people to stop harassing her. Hailey then stated that at the time she felt like she was half joking but half serious too. She found it a bit funny but serious and she couldn't believe she could do such a thing. Apart from that, in the next conversation, Alex said that Hailey likes to read comments from netizens on the internet. Then Hailey also stated that she had to refrain from doing this all the time because according to her the internet is a poison pit but she just wanted to know something.

Analysis of Datum 3

Hailey's statement above belongs to the class of assertive illocutionary acts of the stating type because Hailey tries to express what she feels. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) this type is the type that is used by someone to state what is really happening or what they are feeling. Hailey addressed Alex by stating that she felt like she was half joking but half serious when she asked netizens to stop

harassing her. Then Hailey also stated that she had to refrain from reading netizens' comments all the time because according to her the internet is a poison pit, therefore Hailey's statement above is included in the type of assertive illocutionary acts of the stating type.

Datum 4

Hailey: **“Standing outside and doing that I just felt like it was it was disrespectful to me to my relationship it just was period the end but I think I’ve endured so much disrespect and I still do to this day that there was like a part of me that was just like another day another negative sleigh.”**

Alex: “It is so depressing”

Context of Datum 4

In the conversation above, the characters, time and place are still the same, namely Alex and Hailey Bieber who conducted an interview at the Call Her Daddy podcast studio on September 28, 2022. The topic discussed was Hailey's statement that she felt that her relationship with Justin was not respected by netizens and the conversation taken from minute 34:50 to 35:12. In the short conversation, Hailey revealed that what people were doing was disrespectful to her and her relationship with husband Justin. She has endured so much disrespect and she still does today what she feels like she has become a part of her.

Analysis of Datum 4

much disrespect, one of which was not respecting her relationship with Justin, besides that she also stated that what she felt had become a part of her, therefore Hailey's statement above is included in the type of assertive illocutionary acts of the stating type.

Datum 5

Alex: "Hailey what do you think the internet wants you to do"

Hailey: **"I don't know I legit don't know"**

Alex: "Like if you were trying to get under it like"

Hailey: **"I'm like sometimes I joke around I'm like would they be happy if I like just moved away and like locked myself in a house and just like I don't know I don't know I don't know what the goal is that's what's so funny is I'm just like I don't try to understand like what is the goal."**

Context of Datum 5:

In the conversation above, there are 2 beautiful women, namely Alex and Hailey Bieber. They conducted an interview on September 28, 2022, which took place at the Call Her Daddy podcast studio in New York, United States. The topic discussed is what netizens really want to do to Hailey and the conversation taken from minute 36:08 to 36:18. Alex asked Hailey what she thinks the internet or netizens want her to do then Hailey replied that she really doesn't know what the internet or netizens want from Hailey. She also stated that sometimes she likes to joke around, she's kind of locked herself in the house so she really doesn't know what the netizens' goals are nor does she try to understand what the goals are and that she finds it funny.

Analysis of Datum 5

Hailey's utterance above included in the type of assertive illocutionary acts stating because Hailey stated that Hailey really did not understand what netizens

really wanted Hailey to do and for what purpose Hailey did not understand. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) stating is type that refer to a truth. Hailey conveyed to Alex by stating that she didn't know what netizens wanted for her and she tried to understand what her true intentions were but she still didn't understand, therefore Hailey's utterance above included in the type of stating assertive illocutionary acts.

Datum 6

Alex: "Can you try to explain what does it feel like to have millions of people against your relationship like what does that feel like on a day-to-day basis to you"
 Hailey: **"I guess the biggest thing is like I think it's sad I think it's sad to be against someone's happiness I think it's sad to not wish somebody well who am I supposed to be that would be acceptable and then that means that I'm living for other people and that means that I'm being a people pleaser which I struggle with a lot I do want people to like me it does bother me when people just don't like me simply because of the rumors they've heard or the ideas they've come up with or things that they've seen like it makes me sad but I think I've had to come to the point in the realization of like there is no way that you exist as a person especially not as a person with a platformer in the public eye where everybody loves you and that's even in life in general even if I was just in a normal situation not everybody's going like you I'm just existing in front of a lot of people so it's very easy to make up your like make decisions about how you feel about someone yeah especially when there's so much access to look at them and see what they're doing in their social media and there's photos and there's just like life so I don't know I think that sometimes it feels really heavy."**

Context of Datum 6

In the data above, there are 2 well-known figures, namely Alex and Hailey Bieber, they conducted an interview on September 28, 2022 at the Call Her Daddy podcast studio in New York, United States. The topic they discussed was related to how Hailey felt, who had millions of people against her relationship with her husband Justin and the conversation taken from minute 37:19 to 37:36. Alex

asked Hailey how it felt to have millions of people ending Hailey's relationship with Justin and Hailey answered that it was very sad because fighting someone's happiness, not expecting something good to happen to other people is very sad. She also said that she wants people to like her because when people don't like her just because of the rumors they know, they hear or the ideas that netizens make it bothers her and makes Hailey feel sad but she realized that in life there must be something negative, so according to her, if there are people who don't like her, it's normal because in normal situations, not everyone will like us, she said but she also sometimes felt that it felt very heavy.

Analysis of Datum 6

Hailey's statement above is included in the assertive illocutionary acts stating type because Hailey stated that having millions of relationship opponents is very sad and she tries to make sense of the situation but still feels that what she is experiencing is very hard. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) stating is a type that contains a truth. Hailey conveyed to Alex by stating that she also wants people to like her because when people don't like her it's just because of rumors they know, they hear or ideas that netizens annoy her and make Hailey feel sad but she realized that in life there must be something which is negative, therefore Hailey's statement above is included in the assertive illocutionary acts of the stating type.

Datum 7

Alex: "What has been your lowest moment since all of this began?"

Hailey: **"When things can get really dark and you can start having thoughts of like it not being worth it anymore or not wanting to be here anymore"**

Context of Datum 7

In this conversation, Alex and Hailey Bieber conducted an interview at the Call her Daddy podcast studio in New York, United States on September 28, 2022. The topic they discussed was related to the lowest moments that Hailey experienced and the conversation taken from minute 38:56 to 39:00. In that short conversation Alex asked Hailey what was the lowest moment when all of this started. Then Hailey answered that the lowest moment in her life when all of this started was when things got really dark and she could think that it wasn't worth it and she didn't want to be here anymore (to be in that situation).

Analysis of Datum 7

Hailey's statement above is included in the assertive illocutionary acts type of stating because Hailey stated that the lowest moment in her life was when things got really dark or difficult and she didn't want to be here anymore. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) stating is a type used to express what they really feel. Hailey conveyed to Alex by stating that when things get very dark and she tries to start thinking about the things she likes it won't be valuable anymore and she doesn't want to be in that situation anymore, therefore Hailey's utterance included in the type of stating assertive illocutionary acts.

Datum 8

Alex: "To close out kind of the chapter of what everything we were discussing what would you say to her fans like just coming from your heart they're all sitting listening to you having an open mind let's pretend they had it what would you say to her fans?"

Hailey: **"I think I would say the first thing I would say is you're not obligated to like me but I believe that no matter what there can always be mutual respect between people and to me that means just you don't have to say anything you don't have to like me but you don't have to say anything either"**

because behind this person that you're looking at on a screen is a person with a brain and a heart and emotions and issues that I face and so do you and so does Alex and so does every single person in this room so you just yeah I think just Mutual like respect and decency and and know that what you say can have impact and know that yeah I guess that's what I would say”

Context of Datum 8

In the data above, Alex and Hailey Bieber were at the Call Her Daddy podcast studio in New York, United States of America to conduct an interview. They did on September 28, 2022. The topic discussed was the messages Hailey had to Selena Gomez fans and the conversation taken from minute 43:34 to 43:51. In the conversation Alex asked what Hailey would say from the bottom of her heart to Selena's fans who hate Hailey. Then Hailey stated that the first thing she wanted to convey was that people didn't have to like her and she also said that she believed that whatever happened there was always mutual respect between other people and her. People also don't need to say anything because according to her behind the person you see on this screen is person who has emotions and even the problems they are facing. Likewise with other people, therefore Hailey hopes that we can all respect each other and treat each other politely because what you say will have a path.

Analysis of Datum 8

Hailey's utterance above included in the stating type of assertive illocutionary acts because Hailey states something she feels and messages specifically for her haters or Selena Gomez fans. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) stating is type that used to express what they really feel. Hailey conveyed

to Alex by stating what she was feeling in her opinion someone didn't have to like her. Hailey hopes that we can all respect each other and treat each other politely, therefore Hailey's utterance above included in the stating type assertive illocutionary act.

Datum 9

Alex: "At any point did Justin or any literally anyone ever ask his ex to help put an end to the harassment that her fans put you through."

Hailey: **"No what I will say is that she has been in this industry much longer than I have and maybe there's something that she knows about like it wouldn't fix anything."**

Context of Datum 9

In the short conversation above, Alex and Hailey conducted an interview on September 28, 2022, located at the Call Her Daddy podcast studio in New York, United States. The topic they discussed was about Justin or someone once asking Selena to help end the harassment that her fans were making against Hailey. The conversation taken from minute 45:34 to 45:49. Alex asked Hailey if Justin or anyone else ever asked Selena for help to end the chants that Selena fans were doing to Hailey then Hailey said no and she would say that Selena was longer and earlier in the world industry. She also stated that if there was anything she knew it wouldn't fix anything.

Analysis of Datum 9

Hailey's statement above is included in the type of stating assertive illocutionary acts because Hailey stated that no one asked Selena to stop harassing her and she also stated that Selena had taken longer to enter the industry than her. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) the type of stating is an act is used to express

the meaning of something. By stating a person conveys knowledge to others. Hailey conveyed to Alex by stating that no one asked Selena to stop harassing her, so Hailey's statement above was included in the type of stating assertive illocutionary act.

Datum 10

Alex: "Have you guys ever spoken"

Hailey: **"Yes"**

Alex: "And then like recently no I don't guess not recently but like after your marriage "

Hailey: **"Yes so that's why I'm like it's all respect it's all love that's also why I feel like well if everybody on our side knows what happened."**

Context of Datum 10

In the data taken by the researcher, there were two women who conducted the interview, namely Alex as the host and Hailey Bieber as the resource person. They conducted an interview at the Call Her Daddy podcast studio located in New York, United States. The topic discussed was related to Hailey and Selena's friendship and the conversation taken from minute 46:43 to 46:51. Alex asked Hailey if Hailey and Selena ever spoke to each other after her marriage to Justin then Hailey said "Yes" and Hailey respected her and that is also the reason why Hailey felt good if everyone on her side knew what was really going on.

Analysis of Datum 10

Hailey's utterance above included in the stating type of assertive illocutionary acts because Hailey stated that Hailey and Selena had spoken to each other. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) the type is used by someone to state what is really happening or what they are feeling. Hailey conveyed to Alex by stating that Hailey and Selena had spoken to each other even after Hailey married

Justin. Apart from that, Hailey also stated that she felt good if everyone on our side knew what really happened, so Hailey's statement above was included in the type of stating assertive illocutionary act.

Datum 11

Alex: "It's hard to make friends when you're in a position where you don't know people's intentions right do you have a hard time trusting people "

Hailey: **"Sometimes I feel like I'm the type of person and I've always been this way where I'm like I trust people until they prove me wrong which is like I guess sometimes can be a dangerous way to be I'm a people person like I love to connect with people I love meeting new people I sometimes I have a hard time with like becoming like friends with someone or close to someone but like I love being cool with people and like being social and meeting people and knowing their story and like where are they from"**

Context of Datum 11

In the data above there are two famous figures namely Alex and Hailey. They conducted interviews with Alex as the host and Hailey as a guest speaker or star. They did so at the Call Her daddy podcast studio in New York, United States on September 28, 2022. The topic discussed was Hailey's trust in others and the conversation was taken from 5:38 to 5:48. In the conversation above, Alex said that it would be difficult for us to find friends if we were in a position where we did not know other people's intentions, so it was difficult to trust other people. Then Hailey stated that sometimes she easily trusts other people, likes connecting with people she loves, likes meeting new people but on the other hand she also sometimes has difficulty making friends with someone or even being close to someone. She also stated that she likes to be cool with people who like to hang out, know their stories, and where they come from.

Analysis of Datum 11

Hailey's utterance above is included in the stating type of assertive illocutionary acts because Hailey stated that she easily trusts other people. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) the type is used by someone to state what is really happening or what they are feeling. Hailey conveyed to Alex by stating that she can trust people so much that other people can prove her wrong, besides that she can be friendly to other people, like meeting people she likes even with new people. She also stated that she likes to socialize and likes to listen to other people's stories, so Hailey's utterance above included in the type of stating assertive illocutionary act.

Datum 12

Alex: "Have you ever had someone take advantage of you and your situation and like kind of love that it's like oh I get this lifestyle around her and like how do you deal with that?"

Hailey: **Mm-hmm my personality is very like I don't do well with confrontation I don't like to like confront awkward situations I'm trying to work on it I'm trying to be better at that but I never want to like I've always been the type of person we're like I don't want to like end things on like a sour note with a person because especially if there's someone like in an industry where I have to see them or like if we're going to be out somewhere and I have to see like I don't want to walk into a room and feel like I have beef with someone like that stresses me out big time crazy.**

Context of Datum 12

In the data above, there are two figures namely Alex as the host and Hailey as the resource person. They conducted an interview on September 28, 2022, which was located at the Call Her Daddy podcast studio in New York, United States. The topic discussed was about Hailey not being good at confrontation and the conversation was taken from minute 6:38 to 6:49. In the conversation above

Alex asked Hailey if Hailey had ever had someone take advantage of her then Hailey stated that she doesn't take confrontation well she also added that she doesn't like being in awkward situations. She once tried to improve and get better in the condition but she failed and remained her old personality.

Analysis of Datum 12

Hailey's utterance above included in the stating type of assertive illocutionary acts because Hailey stated that she is not good at confrontation and does not like to face awkward situations. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) stating type contains a truth. Hailey conveyed to Alex by stating that she has tried to get better at confronting and dealing with awkward situations but still doesn't want to be the type of person who easily confronts and likes to deal with awkward situations. Therefore, Hailey's statement above is included in the type of stating assertive illocutionary act.

Datum 13

Alex: "So many people in the world are fascinated by you and fascinated by your life and I think the public can kind of feel that from you of like you don't like confrontation you rarely will speak out on things if there's drama."

Hailey: **"Well I think based on what you're saying like one of the I think issues with that is that then you get stuck having to explain yourself for every little thing and I had to get over that because I was in a place at one point where I felt like I wanted to like explain the narrative and explain myself and like that's also exhausting so if it's like every single time I do an interview or if I say something and there's going to be something that people are like why would she say that or like she's wrong for saying that or that doesn't make sense you said marriage is hard work and then I said that everybody was like that's not a good sign if you think that it's like hard like it's like no matter what I say I'm always going to have to be explaining myself to people which is why I actually hate doing interviews where they're like it's like a blurb of a longer thing that I said that's just so out of context and then I'm going to feel like I'm explaining myself."**

Alex realized that a lot of people were fascinated by Hailey even with her life and according to Alex people could feel that Hailey didn't like confrontation and she would rarely talk about things if there was drama. Then Hailey stated that sometimes she felt stuck trying to explain herself even the little things she had to handle on her own and according to her it was tiring. If he is doing an interview or when he is trying to explain something, netizens will find fault with him saying "like why did he say that or did he say that wrong or it doesn't make sense" but Hailey said that she should still explain herself to people. This is one reason why Hailey absolutely hates interviews.

Analysis of Datum 13

Hailey's utterance above is included in the stating type of assertive illocutionary acts because Hailey stated that she hates doing interviews because she has to explain something in detail. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) stating is used by someone to state what is really happening or what they are feeling. Hailey conveyed Alex by stating she was doing an interview or when she tried to explain something, netizens would find fault with her saying things like "why did she say that or did she say it was wrong or doesn't make sense" but Hailey said she should still explain herself to the people. This is one of the reasons

why Hailey hates interviews so much. Therefore, Hailey's statement above is included in the type of stating assertive illocutionary act.

Datum 14

Alex: **"People** don't want it to make sense people really want that statement to be like the marriage is ending like here we go."

Hailey: **"But people have been saying that since the beginning so that's why at this point I'm not as I was more sensitive about it I don't really feel sensitive about it now because I'm just like totally no matter what I say it's like the marriage is ending like every single time I say something."**

Hailey: **"About my own relationship it's like there's something wrong with it so it's like I just don't care people have been saying this now for four years."**

Context of Datum 14

In the conversation above, there are two women, namely Alex as the host and Hailey Bieber as the guest star. They conducted an interview at the Call Her Daddy podcast studio in New York, United States on September 28, 2022. The topic discussed was netizens' wishes for the end of Hailey and Justin's marriage and the conversation was taken from minute 11:18 to 11:43. In that conversation Alex said that people don't want to make sense of things and people really want to declare the end of Hailey and Justin's marriage. then Hailey stated that people or netizens have been saying this since the beginning of their marriage or about 4 years. Hailey thinks like something is wrong with her involvement but Hailey doesn't care what other people say about her relationship with Justin.

Analysis of Datum 14

Hailey's utterance above included in the type of stating assertive illocutionary acts because Hailey stated about the desire of netizens who do not respect their relationship with Justin. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) stating

is a type that contains a truth. Hailey conveyed to Alex that netizens had said about wanting to end her marriage to her husband Justin so that at this point Hailey wasn't too sensitive when she heard those words. Therefore, Hailey's statement above is included in the type of stating assertive illocutionary acts.

Datum 15

Alex: "Hailey okay you married one of the most famous people on the planet Justin Bieber what are the best parts about being married to Justin."

Hailey: **"Well I think the best parts are that he's my best friend and there's nothing better than being with the person that makes you smile the most makes you laugh the most like he's just literally the best human to me ever and I think that he's a person who has been through a lot and shouldn't have gotten to the other side of a lot of what he's been through and he has and he's overcome so many different things in his life for being famous so young and the fact that he's as normal as he is he's literally just to me I feel like he's a very like normal regular guy I've known him for a very long time we were friends for a long time before anything else and like I just love him."**

Context of Datum 15

In the data above there are two beautiful young women who interview, they are Alex as hosts and Hailey as resource persons. They conducted an interview at the Podcast Call Her Daddy studio in New York United States. The topic they discussed about the best part of marrying Justin Bieber and the conversation taken from minute 11:59 to 12:09. In this conversation Alex tells Hailey that she has married a very famous person on earth and Alex asks what is the best part of being married to Justin. Then Hailey replied that the best part is that Justin is her best friend and there is nothing better than being with the person who can make her smile the most, make her laugh and Hailey also added that Justin is the best human being for her. According to her Justin is a person who has been through a lot of things in his life and he should not deserve the other side of

the many things he has been through. Justin has overcome a lot in his life because he was famous when he was very young and Hailey says that Justin is a normal and true man for her. Hailey has known him for a long time they are also old friends and Hailey loves him.

Analysis of Datum 15

Hailey's utterance above included in the type of stating assertive illocutionary acts because Hailey stated about the best parts of being married to a very famous person, Justin Bieber. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) stating is type that used to express what they really feel. Hailey conveyed to Alex that the best part is that Justin is her best friend and there is nothing better than being with the person who can make her smile the most, make her laugh and Hailey also added that Justin is the best human being for her. According to her, Justin is a person who has gone through a lot of things in his life and he does not deserve to accept the other side of the many things he has gone through. Therefore, Hailey's utterance above included in the type of stating assertive illocutionary acts.

Datum 16

Alex: "How has being married to someone with that level of Fame impacted your identity?"

Hailey: **"Where do I start um well I think even for starters this even me talking about him or talking about our relationship people will take that and be like all she ever talks about is her relationship with him and even something like that I'm just like well we are married and he's a huge part of my life and obviously people are very interested in like our life together and he's a humongous public figure so it's like it's a little bit unavoidable at times."**

Context of Datum 16

In the conversation above there are two famous artists, namely Alex as Host and Hailey Bieber as a guest speaker. They conducted an interview at the

Call Her Daddy podcast studio in New York, United States on September 28, 2022. The topic they discussed was what it's like to be married to someone who is very famous and influences Hailey's identity the conversation taken from minute 14:30 to 14:38. In the conversation Alex asked Hailey how to relate to someone so famous and it must have affected her identity. Then Hailey said that Justin was a big part of her life and it was certain that people would like and be interested in their lives together. Justin is such a huge public figure that sometimes they more or less can't keep things out of the public eye.

Analysis of Datum 16

Hailey's utterance above belongs to the type of stating assertive illocutionary acts because Hailey stated that Justin is a big part of her life and it is certain that people will like and be interested in their life together. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) stating is used by someone to state what is really happening or what they are feeling. Hailey conveyed Alex Justin is such a huge public figure that sometimes they are more or less unable to hide things from the public eye, therefore Hailey's utterance above is included in the type of stating assertive illocutionary acts.

2. Denying

This illocutionary act is used to deny something. The function of this type of speech act is to reject something from someone else.

Datum 1

Alex: "I think everyone in the world almost knows that you have been bullied and harassed on the internet for almost four years now like that's a fact and it's."

Hailey: **"But I do think it has changed okay I will give credit to say that I do think that four years ago three years ago two and a half years ago because of**

how intense it was it made me just very like closed off and like not want to share anything really of myself on the internet I didn't really want to be open I would get a pit in my stomach doing interviews because I'm just like I can't like I I'm it's like it's like being like traumatized kind of like you're too scared to like speak or open yourself up or say the wrong thing."

Context of Datum 1

In the conversation above Alex conducted an interview with Hailey Bieber. They conducted an interview on September 28, 2022 at the Podcast studio Call Her Daddy, located in New York, United States. The topic discussed was Hailey's response to her being harassed on the internet for almost four years. The conversation was taken from minute 27:01 to 27:10. Alex opined that almost everyone in the world knew Hailey was bullied and harassed on the internet for almost four years. Then Hailey cut Alex off and said "but I do think it has changed okay" she stated that things had changed for the better and a few years ago Hailey was very secretive and really didn't want to open up. She would feel sick to her stomach if she did an interview because she didn't like it. Hailey has also experienced trauma such as being afraid to speak up or opening up or saying the wrong thing.

Analysis of Datum 1

Hailey's utterance above belongs to the type of denying assertive illocutionary acts because when Alex was talking about the news of harassment of Hailey Bieber on the internet Hailey interrupted her conversation and said that her harassment on the internet had changed for the better than in previous years. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) Denying type is used to deny something from other people. Hailey conveyed to Alex that the intimidation and harassment

towards hers had improved from the previous year. Therefore, Hailey's statement above is included in the type of denying assertive illocutionary acts.

Datum 2

Alex: "Can you explain what happened when you were taking photos on the red carpet with your husband at the Met Gala in 2021."

Hailey: **"Oh and people were screaming so yes I could hear everyone screaming and again I think there's a certain part of you that has a numbness of just like I was like really surprised I could kind of hear it but I didn't know if that's what was really going on until I saw the video after the whole thing of everybody being like "oh he's trying to tell her not to cry" that was not true it wasn't making me cry um although it's a very disrespectful thing to do towards anybody I felt like I had something in my eye that was see that's just what goes to show you how out of context things can be seen when he's like trying to help me I'm like I feel like there's something in my eye do you see something in my eye and I'm going like this and he's like no no you're good."**

Context of Datum 2

In the data above, Alex has conducted an interview with Hailey Bieber at the Call Her Daddy podcast studio located in New York, United States. They conducted an interview on September 28, 2022 and the topic they discussed was the incident that happened when Hailey took a photo on the red carpet with your husband at the Met Gala in 2021. The conversation above was taken from minute 33:09 to 33:18. In the conversation above, Alex asked Hailey about things that had become a topic of conversation among netizens on social media about something that happened when Hailey and her husband took a photo at the 2021 Met Gala. Then Hailey immediately contradicted the statement about people's screams at that time and revealed what was really what happened then. She revealed that she heard people screaming but she didn't know what the people were saying, she didn't know what was going on so she saw the video that was

recorded with her husband at the time. In the video, Hailey looks like she's wiping away tears from her eyes and netizens think she's crying and her husband tells her not to cry. Then this was denied by Hailey in fact, at that time Hailey asked her husband "is there something in my eye?" to which the husband replied "No, you are good".

Analysis of Datum 2

Hailey's utterance above belongs to the type of denying assertive illocutionary acts because netizens thought that at the Met Gala 2021 Hailey was crying, but in fact there was only something glimmering in her eyes. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) Denying type is used to deny something from other people. Hailey conveyed to Alex that in the video, Hailey looks like she is wiping tears from her eyes and netizens think she is crying and her husband tells her not to cry. Then this was denied by Hailey even, at that time Hailey asked her husband "is there something in my eye?" to which the husband replied, "No, you are fine", therefore Hailey's words above are included in the type of denying assertive illocutionary acts.

Datum 3

Alex: "And as this is happening everyone's chanting was it there was I don't even know if it was their relationship name or just her name so then you take the sunglasses."

Hailey: **"Yeah and the sunglasses were just part of my look they were just part of my look I knew I was going to wear the sunglasses regardless on the carpet for some photos and then some without um but yeah I did hear people yelling I it wasn't making me almost cry um I think seeing the video back after made me like damn like that sucks that that's the energy people are like putting out into like that you would even spend your time."**

Context of Datum 3

In the data above, Alex and Hailey conducted an interview at the Call Her Daddy podcast studio located in New York, United States on September 28, 2022. The topic discussed was Hailey wearing sunglasses when taking a photo at the 2021 Met Gala and the conversation above was taken from minute 34:10 to 34:19. Alex asked Hailey about her wearing sunglasses in a photo with her husband while on the red carpet. Then Hailey revealed that the sunglasses were indeed part of her look and that she would be wearing them for a photo shoot on the 2021 Met Gala red carpet.

Analysis of Datum 3

Hailey Bieber's utterance above included in the group of denying assertive illocutionary acts because Hailey denied the estimates of netizens who thought that Hailey used her glasses to cover her tears. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) denying is a type of assertive illocutionary acts which means denial. Hailey conveyed to Alex what really happened, she revealed that from the start Hailey had planned to wear her sunglasses during a photo shoot at the 2021 Met Gala and at that time she also heard people screaming but this didn't make Hailey want to cry at all Therefore, Hailey's statement above is included in the type of denying assertive illocutionary acts because her words contain rejection.

Datum 4

Alex: “That's like a very public example I feel like of you having to go through that is there anything that comes to mind that was supposed to be a happy moment for you for you and Justin whatever and it was ruined by harassment or bullying or this concept of his past.”

Hailey: **“They've never ruined anything for me they've never they've never they're not ruining my life they're not ruining my happiness and that I think is really the win of the whole thing you're actually not taking anything away from me so that's what I just keep stepping forward with it's like you can't take this away from me you cannot take away my happiness my relationship um my business my career like you just you can you can try and you can be mad about it but it doesn't change anything is my point.”**

Context of Datum 4

In the data above, there are two well-known young figures, namely Alex as the host and Hailey as the guest speaker. They conducted an interview on September 28, 2022 which took place at the Call Her Daddy podcast studio in New York, United States. The topic discussed was about his denial regarding netizens who ruined his happiness and the conversation was taken from minute 35:12 to 35:14. In the conversation above Alex tells Hailey that something that should be a happy moment for Hailey and Justin or else was spoiled by vandalism and intimidation. Then Hailey denied that netizens never spoiled anything from her. Hailey said that netizens have never ruined her life, never ruined her happiness. So that he continues to move forward as if one cannot take away her happiness, opposites, neither business nor improvement.

Analysis of Datum 4

Hailey Bieber's utterance above included in the type of denying assertive illocutionary acts because Hailey denies about netizens who ruined her life. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) denying is a type of assertive illocutionary acts

which means denial. Hailey conveyed to Alex that netizens have never ruined anything from her even her life and her happiness. Therefore, Hailey's statement above is included in the type of denying assertive illocutionary acts because her utterance contain rejection.

3. Informing

In this type the speaker provides information through utterances, but this type is only used when the other person does not know the information. The function of this type of speech is to inform other people about things that are not yet known by the speech partner.

Datum 1

Alex: "How did you pick your outfit for today"

Hailey: **"I just wanted to feel comfortable and I feel like I just wanted to wear like jeans and a t-shirt and be cozy little but like still cute still like a little bye"**

Alex: "I feel like that's your entire vibe is always being comfortable looking and then having like a tinge of like super like sexy and cute but like still like you can"

Hailey: **"I can't stand being uncomfortable I like I'll do it for a certain amount of time sorry amount of time."**

Context of Datum 1

In the data above, there are two characters, namely Alex and Hailey, who conducted an interview at the Call Her daddy podcast studio in New York, United States on September 28, 2022. The topic discussed was Hailey's outfit that she wore during the podcast interview and the conversation above was taken from minutes 0:21 to 0:46. In the conversation above Alex asked Hailey about the clothes Hailey was wearing during the interview. Then Hailey said that she wanted to feel comfortable in jeans and a t-shirt. Alex replied by revealing that the

way Hailey always looks comfortable and looks cute. Then he was 9 that he could not stand anything uncomfortable.

Analysis of Datum 1

Hailey Bieber's utterance above included in the type of informing assertive illocutionary acts because Hailey informs Alex about her outfit during in the podcast studio. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) informing is a type of assertive illocutionary acts which means informing something to other people where other people still do not know the information before. Hailey conveyed to Alex that she likes wearing comfortable clothes like jeans and t-shirts. Besides that she also revealed that she can't stand the discomfort, if she likes something she will do it within a certain time. Therefore, Hailey's statement above is included in the type of informative assertive illocutionary act because her statement contains information for other people who do not know about it before.

Datum 2

Alex: "From your point of view can you explain why the internet was so angry over your engagement to Justin"

Hailey: **"First of all I think one thing is that we're both really young that's I think honestly that's for starters which I totally understand when we got engaged I was 21 and he was 24. yeah 24 and 21. I personally never thought I was going to get married that young like I always thought I would be maybe getting married now and I'm 25 now and I still think I'm really young I think the timing was obviously very rapid and very fast which now being four years past that looking back on it I I totally get it I'm like yeah that seemed really drastic and really crazy because but that was what we felt was a decision between the two of us and it felt correct for the two of us at the time and clearly."**

Context of Datum 2

In the data above, there are two women who have conducted interviews, namely Alex as the host and Hailey as the resource person. They conducted an

interview at the Call Her Daddy podcast studio located in New York, United States on September 28, 2022. The topic discussed was Hailey's explanation regarding the anger of netizens over her engagement to Justin and the conversation above was taken from 16:03 to 16:14. Alex asked Hailey to explain why netizens were so angry about her engagement to Justin then Hailey replied that according to her netizens were very angry because of their very young age. At that time Hailey was 21 years old and Justin was 24 years old. Hailey herself never thought that she would marry young because previously she thought she would get married at about 25 years old. She felt time flies so fast and her marriage has been 4 years already.

Analysis of Datum 2

Hailey Bieber's utterance above are included in the type of informative assertive illocutionary acts because Hailey informed Alex about the anger of netizens over her engagement to Justin Bieber. Based on the theory of Searle (1969) informing is a type of assertive illocutionary acts which means informing something to other people where other people still do not know the information before. Hailey conveyed to Alex why netizens were angry about her marriage to the famous artist because according to her they were too young and Hailey never thought that she would marry that young. At that time Justin was 24 years old and Hailey 21 years. Therefore, Hailey's statement above is included in the type of informative assertive illocutionary act because her statement contains information for other people who do not know about it before.

B. Discussion

Based on the findings of the data analysis, the researcher described the utterances produced by Hailey Bieber using the theory from Searle (1969) regarding assertive illocutionary acts. Based on this classification, the researcher found around 22 utterances that contain several types of assertive illocutionary acts that have been found by researcher, such as stating, denying, and informing. Stating is the type most often used by Hailey Bieber to state something and answer questions by Alex, the host of the Call Her Daddy podcast. Hailey often used the stating type because in this podcast she tried to tell what really happened. In general, type of stating is used to state something or state a certain situation to other people that is real and true. A small example, like when Alex asked Hailey about an incident that had become a hot topic of conversation on social media during a photo shoot at the 2021 Met Gala. At that time netizens thought Hailey was wiping away her tears and Justin told Hailey not to cry. Later on the Call Her Daddy podcast Hailey Bieber stated what really happened. In reality, Hailey Bieber was not crying but had something in her eye and asked Justin to check. It did not stop there, when the photo shoot started, Hailey was seen wearing her sunglasses but netizens thought that Hailey did this solely to cover her eyes after crying. Even though from the beginning she decided to wear her sunglasses for a photo shoot at the 2021 Met Gala.

There are several types that are rarely used, such as denying there are 5 utterances and informing there are 2 utterances. According to the theory put forward by Searle (1969) the type of denying is usually used to reject something

while the informing type is usually used to inform something to other people who do not know the information. Hailey Bieber rarely used the two types of assertive illocutionary acts above because in the type of denying she only rejected some of the comments of netizens and Alex which she thinks are not in accordance with her. As for the type of informing, she rarely used it because in the podcast she only informed a number of things that netizens did not know before. In addition, there are also several types that were not found in the present research, such as affirming, boasting, and complaining. The affirmation type is the type used to assert something and Hailey Bieber does not use the affirmation type because she was not trying to assert something to Alex. While the type of boasting is a type of illocutionary act that leads to arrogance. She does not brag at all on the podcast so she does not use this type. The complaining type is the type usually used for complaining and she also does not use this type because she does not complain about anything.

This research is similar to previous studies that found assertive types but not all types were found. Their finding is varied, such as Abdullah, Muhammad (2021) who only found stating, informing and complaining types because he used the Korean English man YouTube channel as the research object. Meanwhile, Indrawati et al (2021) found the type of informing, stating, denying, and complaining because they used local guides as research objects. Apart from that, Sianipar (2022) found stating, informing and affirming types because she used Instagram and Twitter as research objects. Yulistiana F & Widyastuti (2022) found the stating, denying, informing and complaining types because they used

Joe Biden's speech about the first presidential debate as the research object. As for Kusumah, Febriant Argadie et al (2022) found stating, informing, and denying because they used a YouTube video entitled Similarities between Christianity and Islam by Dr Zakir Naik. Meanwhile, in this research, using the Call Her Daddy podcast as the research object found three types of assertive illocutionary acts such as stating, informing and denying. This research is in contrast with Zafirah et al (2019), Nono & Prayudha (2022), Sitorus et al (2022), Dwi Umami, et al (2022), Hutajulu & Herman (2019), Fitriani, & Rasmita (2020), Thalia, Namira (2021), Ratri & Bram (2022), Prastio et al (2020), Aurelia (2022) they found several types of illocutionary acts, such as assertive, directive, expressive, commissive, declarative, and the most dominant is assertive illocutionary acts. Whereas in this research the researcher found several types of assertive illocutionary acts such as stating, informing, denying and the most dominant type is stating. The researcher cannot explain assertive types completely because researchers cannot find affirming, boasting, and complaining types in the Call Her Daddy podcast.

The benefits of the present research for previous research are that this research adds ideas related to research on assertive illocutionary acts. In previous research as the researcher found, namely research on refusal commissive speech acts in ice age continental drift movie Aisyah Puspita (2022) where this research only focused on refusal commissive speech acts and does not discuss assertive illocutionary acts besides that it also used theory which is different, namely Austin's theory while in the present research the researcher examines Hailey Bieber's utterances which focus on assertive illocutionary acts using Searle's

theory (1969). In addition, the researcher also found previous research on assertive illocutionary acts Intan Indah P (2019) she has analyzed assertive illocutionary acts using the same theory as current research, namely the theory put forward by Searle (1969) but she used different data, namely from Boss Baby Movie. In her research she has found several assertive illocutionary acts such as 3 types of stating, 1 type of denying, 4 types of informing, 2 types of complaining, 3 types of affirming and the most frequently used type of assertive illocutionary act is the informing type whereas in the current research the researcher has found 16 stating types, 4 denying types, 2 informing types and the most frequently used is the stating type. Therefore, the present research is useful for adding ideas and can also be used as reading material or reference so that research related to assertive illocutionary acts can be more widespread and more detailed.

The scope of the present research is the theory of Searle (1969) which explains about assertive illocutionary acts and aims to analyze speech acts in a pragmatic study that focuses on Hailey Bieber's utterances. While the limitation is the analysis of assertive illocutionary acts expressed by Hailey Bieber. In the present research, there are several types of assertive illocutionary acts that have not been studied because they were not found such as affirming, boasting, and complaining. The researcher suggests to future researchers to conduct research on assertive illocutionary acts but by using different types and different data so that in the future research on illocutionary acts does not only examine assertive acts but examines several other types so that they are broader and more in-depth again.

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In the discussion of this chapter, the researcher will describe the conclusion and followed by suggestions from the researcher herself. The conclusion contained in this chapter are formed based on the discussion of previous chapters. In addition, researcher will also provide research recommendation as to what can be done in the future.

A. Conclusion

In conclusion, this research examines the analysis of assertive illocutionary acts contained in the Call Her Daddy podcast, with utterance produced by Hailey Bieber. The researcher concludes the research as follows:

1. The researcher found three types of assertive illocutionary acts the first is stating. There are 16 data related to Searle's (1969) theory Hailey Bieber stated about her self-defense. The second is denying there are 4 data related to Searle's theory (1969) Hailey Bieber denied netizen comments on social media. The last one is informing with 2 data which related to Searle's (1969) theory, Hailey Bieber informed about something that netizens do not know related to their insults on social media. In total there are 22 Hailey Bieber's utterances which contain assertive illocutionary acts. On the other hand, researcher also sort the results of the research from the most to the fewest.
2. Stating is the most common type found in the present research with 16 utterances. Researcher can conclude that Hailey Bieber in the Call Her Daddy podcast often used types of assertive illocutionary acts that she can use to state

something or a real situation to the other person. Hailey Bieber often expressed how she feels by using assertive illocutionary acts of the stating type. The present research is expected to be an insight for students, lecturers, teachers and readers as well as a reference for the world of education, especially in linguistic studies. In addition, the present research can also be used as a lesson about assertive illocutionary acts and quite interesting because assertive illocutionary acts can occur in certain communications or every day. It is can also illustrate that researchers cannot only research written works but can also research something that is contained in social media such as the Call Her Daddy podcast.

B. Suggestion

The limitation of this research is that researcher could not find three types of assertive illocutionary acts such as affirming, boasting and complaining. Therefore, the researcher suggests to the future researchers to use other objects, especially news reporters about supporting the rights of the Palestinian people against oppression, persecution and injustice or Joe Bidden's speeches, so that they can find five types of assertive illocutionary acts such as stating, informing, denying, affirming, boasting and complaining. Assertive are statements of fact because they try to describe a situation. This statement can be evaluated as true or false. This analysis refers to the subject of the Call Her Daddy podcast created by Alexandra Cooper and Sofia Franklyn in 2018. This podcast is an interview podcasts available on the YouTube platform. Therefore, suggestion is researcher address to the teachers or lecturers because the present research is important

enough to be taught to students, especially students who study linguistic studies. Teachers or lecturers can teach their students by using this research as an example of assertive illocutionary act analysis. Furthermore, the next suggestion addressed to students. Students can make the present research as a reference for learning in linguistic studies, especially learning about assertive illocutionary acts contained in a podcast. In addition, it is also a reference if students who want to do their final project. On the other hand, suggestion for future researchers are as a basis for research and a basis for learning for those who wish to research assertive illocutionary acts. In addition, the researcher also recommends analyzing assertive illocutionary acts in other data sources such as written works or other social media besides podcasts so that research on assertive illocutionary acts is even wider and can be found more in the future.

Alex: Haley this is not real fantasy it's a game we can pretend like okay but I love it okay so Kylie hit us up uh we're ready to take over your closet you came in here there's Paparazzi taking photos of you it's a lot how do you handle the pressure of being photographed for the world to see almost every single time you step outside

Hailey Bieber: It's really funny because I was thinking about this coming over here and they were like following me in the car which is like it happens all the time whatever like I know that's going to happen if I'm in La there's not very many ways to avoid it they just sit at the bottom of like my street so it is what it is but I was driving and like sometimes when there's Paparazzi following me I have a flash in my head of like getting out with a baseball bat and literally destroying their car like I literally sometimes it like it makes me just I'm so annoyed that I'm like one of these days I swear to God I'm gonna get out of the car with a [__] baseball bat and I'm going to like destroy their this is a hypothetical situation

Alex: By the way

Alex: Even if it's so you can stick up for yourself

Hailey Bieber: Yeah

Alex: We're working on that today

Hailey Bieber: Yeah

Alex: We're working on that

Hailey Bieber: Even yeah even if it that's something I struggle with even if it's for me sticking up with myself I just want to like because I think there's a way to stick up for yourself and still be cordial I've had situations and or a situation where I feel like there was like a lot of stuff I found out about the situation and then I knew if I confronted the person they were just not gonna own up to any of it so it's like what's the point right if I'm gonna go to you and be like here's what I found out I know that it's true I've seen the proof I've too many people have said something to me about it and they're just gonna be like I can't believe you would believe that about me like that's just not true why am I going to waste my breath with somebody who's just not even going who's not in the place in their life or like the type of person that is going to even receive the confrontation at all because I can do confrontation if it's in a calm appropriate I'm not a yeller like I'm not gonna like freak out and like I'll get fired up when it's something that I'm really like passionate about or defensive about because like I've had that happen to me before but I still always want to end it on like a how did we move forward from here not like and and sometimes the reality I've had to face is that like sometimes that's not possible like sometimes you just can't be around that person or be friends with that person and like it is what it is totally you just have to move on

Alex: So many people in the world are fascinated by you and fascinated by your life and I think the public can kind of feel that from you of like you don't like confrontation you rarely will speak out on things if there's drama which I think so many people do respect you for but how much does that then weigh on you of things piling up on you that it's like when is gonna be a good moment for Haley to just kind of like speak her truth and you've done it a couple times on the internet

which I think people were like oh [___] yes like Haley let's go which we're gonna get into

Hailey Bieber: Well I think based on what you're saying like one of the I think issues with that is that then you get stuck having to explain yourself for every little thing and I had to get over that because I was in a place at one point where I felt like I wanted to like explain the narrative and explain myself and like that's also exhausting so if it's like every single time I do an interview or if I say something and there's going to be something that people are like why would she say that or like she's wrong for saying that or that doesn't make sense you said marriage is hard work and then I said that everybody was like that's not a good sign if you think that it's like hard like it's like no matter what I say I'm always gonna have to be explaining myself to people which is why I actually hate doing interviews where they're like it's like a blurb of a longer thing that I said that's just so out of context and then I'm gonna feel like I'm explaining myself

Alex: What marriage doesn't have ups and downs and in a good way you get

Hailey Bieber: But also what I meant when I said hard work is just like there's compromise there's sacrifice I feel that way in most relationships in my life even friendships even work relationships like they can be tough sometimes I didn't mean it just overall yeah like it's hard and it sucks like that's not what I'm saying at all it's literally the best thing ever the whole sentence of what I said was like he's my best friend I love coming home to him but like yeah it takes work because I'm 25 years old and I have a life and I have a career and I have my own friends so trying to balance making my wants and needs and hopes and dreams work while meshing my life with another human who has his hopes and dreams and career and like we're busy people and we want to be in a marriage so we're making it work and sometimes it's hard how is that not make sense

Alex: People don't want it to make sense people really want that statement to be like the marriage is ending like here we go

Hailey Bieber: But people have been saying that since the beginning so that's why at this point I'm not as I was more sensitive about it I don't really feel sensitive about it now because I'm just like totally no matter what I say it's like the marriage is ending like every single time I say something

Alex: Like here we go

Hailey Bieber: About my own relationship it's like there's something wrong with it so it's like I just don't care people have been saying this now for four years

Alex: So let's get into it you are married

Hailey Bieber: Start sticking my feet

Alex: You're like here we go Alex just go she's literally burrowing in

Hailey Bieber: Like look at my house

Alex: Haley okay you married one of the most famous people on the planet Justin Bieber what are the best parts about being married to Justin

Hailey Bieber: Well I think the best parts are that he's my best friend and there's nothing better than being with the person that makes you smile the most makes you laugh the most like he's just literally the best human to me ever and I think that he's a person who has been through a lot and shouldn't have gotten gotten to the other side of a lot of what he's been through and he has and he's overcome so

many different things in his life for being famous so young and the fact that he's as normal as he is he's literally just to me I feel like he's a very like normal regular guy I guarantee you someone takes this and they like [__] chop it up and make it sound like I said something different um but I've known him for a very long time we were friends for a long time before anything else and like I just love him

Alex: You can see it with the two of you even though we only see stuff I mean I remember when I saw you guys on the beach in Santa Barbara and I grew up I watched Justin Bieber I was like oh like I didn't know what to expect I was definitely intimidated by you guys because we had only met once I was like wait why are they so normal Justin's like hey what's up gives me a hug you're like what are you guys doing on your trip I'm like you guys are so so normal for what how crazy your life is and it's unfortunate that people don't get to see that side of you guys

Hailey Bieber: Yeah he's also like he just has the kindest sweetest most like gentle heart and soul to me and I've always thought that about him obviously he's gone through phases in his life where he was being you know a little out there I didn't want to say like [__] boy because it's like not yeah but like yes and no I don't know I don't know how to describe it but like he was just in a different space in his life and was like I think multimately when people are like acting out it's just because they're hurting and he was just in a space in his life I mean we're all hurting every single day but I think sometimes we go through a season where it's like we're hurting a lot more we're going through a lot more so we're just a different version of ourself that's not really who we are um but like to me he's just the best the most fun like I have the most fun with him he understands me more than anybody ever has in my whole life and I think that goes both ways and he's just my guy

Alex: How has being married to someone with that level of Fame impacted your identity

Hailey Bieber: Where do I start um well I think even for starters this even me talking about him or talking about our relationship people will take that and be like all she ever talks about is her relationship with him and even something like that I'm just like well we are married and he's a huge part of my life and obviously people are very interested in like our life together and he's a humongous public figure so it's like it's a little bit unavoidable at times and I do try to you know have my own thing but it's like our lives are completely meshed together so I don't know I'm like I'm like what do you want from me like of course people are gonna ask me about it they're gonna ask him about it like I just don't see how that's like avoidable as sometimes it is because it's just not necessary to talk about but like even in a situation like this yeah we're married I have his last name like I don't know how I'm supposed to avoid like talking about my life like that's my life

Alex: This person that you happen to be married to happens to also be one of the most famous people

Hailey Bieber: Nobody would be asking me about him if he was someone who had a different type of job or like you know right a nine to five like I just the reality is that it is what it is

Alex: From your point of view can you explain why the internet was so angry over your engagement to Justin

Hailey Bieber: First of all I think one thing is that we're both really young that's I think honestly that's for starters which I totally understand when we got engaged I was 21 and he was 24. yeah 24 and 21. I personally never thought I was going to get married that young like I always thought I would be maybe getting married now and I'm 25 now and I still think I'm really young I think the timing was obviously very rapid and very fast which now being four years past that looking back on it I I totally get it I'm like yeah that seemed really drastic and really crazy because but that was what we felt was a decision between the two of us and it felt correct for the two of us at the time and clearly we were right because here we are four years later and I think just given the timeline of like where he was at before we got back together and what was going on and there was just a lot happening yeah um but I will say too like the only people that really know the truth of the situation and what the timeline really was and how it happened and how it went down or like me and him perception is a really tricky thing because when you're watching something from the outside you can see it one way when it may not really be the reality of what happened behind closed doors and that's a big challenge I think of being somebody who is in the spotlight or being famous is that I know how we got to where we got period like that's I just know how it happened I was there um and I was living it every day so there's just yeah there there's a lot that I can understand why people were so like what is going on like this seems crazy.

Alex: Your husband was in a very public relationship they were kids people were obsessed with the idea of them people were confused on the timeline you're talking about of like is she a homewrecker so I guess my question is Haley were you ever with Justin romantically at the same time as her.

Hailey Bieber: No not one time when him and I started hanging out like okay let's just put it this way when him and I ever started like hooking up or like anything of that sort he was not ever in a relationship ever at any point I would never it's not my character to mess with someone's relationship I would just never do that I was raised better than that I'm not interested in doing that and I never was um I think that there are situations where you can still kind of have like back and forth with someone but even that was not the situation like I can say period Point Blank I was never with him when he was in a relationship with anybody that's the end of it um and I had been involved with him since I was 18. the the timeline also that I think sometimes is in question of like us getting together and getting engaged and him having been spending time with his ex before that um this is so crazy I've literally never talked about this ever I understand again how it looks from the outside and there's a lot of perception there but that was a situation where I I know for a fact that it was the right thing for them to close that door they were not in a relationship at that time but of course there's a very long history there and it's not my relationship it has nothing to do with me so I respect that a lot but I know that it closed a chapter and I think it was the best thing that could have happened for him to move on and be engaged and get married and like move on with with his life in that way and it's hard for me to talk about this because I don't want to talk

on either one of their behalf again because it was their relationship and I honestly respect that very deeply but I just know what was going on when we got back together and I know what had to happen for that to come back together in a healthy way um and I think it was the most healthy mature decision that he could have made and I respect that as a woman I would never want to get into a relationship with someone and be engaged to them and be getting married to them and think in the back of my mind I wonder like if that was really like closed for you and like and I know for a fact that the reason we were able to get back together was because it was very much completely closed and that is respectful to me.

Alex: So let's talk about your experience with there's been a lot of hate on the internet I know you don't like to talk about this stuff but you've never..

Hailey Bieber: It literally makes me so uncomfortable

Alex: Yeah

Hailey Bieber: I'm like I'm like Can't Stop Moving And I'm like crawling because I just feel like there's like a little bit of that like anxiety of like people will probably take it the wrong way or like I just don't want to say something that is like being disrespectful or like bringing up something that can like stir up feelings for someone that like I know that we're just all so far moved on from like any type of drama and I'm so happy for that so like I get nervous about talking about it because I'm like I don't want to like stir anything up or like bring anything up that is going to be like a thing or..

Alex: And I get that and I think the reason unfortunately is you guys aren't completely normal human beings there is a complete world out there that is obsessed with all of you in different ways and then there are people that hate you for who your husband dated back in his past take me through how your husband's past relationship still to this day affects what people are saying about you and to you on the internet.

Hailey Bieber: Well I think like one of the things that we already just covered is that like the timeline of things and like a lot of the hate and the perpetuation comes from like oh you stole him and I guess maybe that just comes from like the fact that they wished that like he had ended up with someone else and that's fine like you can wish that all you want but that's just not the case.

Alex: In December of 2020 a person posted a video encouraging haters to comment on your Instagram live with nasty messages announcing their allegiance for Justin's ex and just like fully harassing you on your life what do you remember feeling on that Instagram live when you saw those comments start popping up.

Hailey Bieber: I don't well I think there's like a certain like almost like numbness that you get where you're just like you just know what's gonna happen it still happens to this day this is you're talking about something that was two years ago now almost three and it's something that's if I was to go live on Instagram right now it would still be happening probably less which is nice but you just reach a point where you're just like you have to just like ignore it and be like okay.

Alex: And didn't Justin come publicly to your defense and like said something.

Hailey Bieber: Well because I know that for him that's hurtful because if we have moved on why can't you like that's kind of just the whole thought process of like it's just hurtful it's hurtful it's bullying.

Alex: It brings me back to the Rob Pattinson and Kristen Stewart the Miley Cyrus and Liam Hemsworth their first love right and people are obsessed I feel like with this concept of like your first relationship somehow it's being pushed onto you as a get the [__] out of the way like let them get back and you're like if I wasn't even here that's not gonna happen so like let us just live our lives I know you go find your partner and you be happy but it's it's hard.

Hailey Bieber: I have had this conversation with a psychiatrist with a therapist before because I'm just like I hate comparison the whole point of this conversation is that we're talking about how my relationship is being compared to something else or I'm being compared to another woman and you know get the [__] out of the way type of a thing so where I'm at and the position I'm in it's not it's not for everybody but everybody has a purpose this but that doesn't necessarily mean that you're supposed to also be 25 and married and doing this or I'm sure I'm I could have nothing figured out right now if in an alternate situation in an alternate life.

Alex: And I think hilly he was America's bad boy sweetheart and so I think there's ownership people and fans.

Hailey Bieber: They're totally's and there's also this like why is it you there's so much of that that I feel like why why you though like and I'm like I don't know.

Alex: Right like I just fell in love

Hailey Bieber: He fell in love we're in love and like it it I I think there was times where like I'd be I can confidently say I I don't think we knew it was gonna be each other several times so like I can't say that yes at 18 years old I knew 100 that that was my husband I don't [__] I didn't [__] know.

Alex: You almost can't live up to the idea of who they think belongs with him

Hailey Bieber: It would have nobody would have this is the thing if it was any if it was another person it's like because so many people have adored him for so long nobody in their mind would have ever been like the person and here's the thing too is like we're talking about a lot of like the negative side of it there's also so many people who have made me feel so embraced and so encouraged and so loved and obviously it has brought me a newfound audience and a newfound um you know there it just there I want to like give credit also to the people who have like supported and been so kind and like so amazing and so great.

Alex: I think everyone in the world almost knows that you have been bullied and harassed on the internet for almost four years now like that's a fact and it's..

Hailey Bieber: But I do think it has changed okay I will give credit to say that I do think that four years ago three years ago two and a half years ago because of how intense it was it made me just very like closed off and like not want to share anything really of myself on the internet I didn't really want to be open I would get a pit in my stomach doing interviews because I'm just like I can't like I'm it's like it's like being like traumatized kind of like you're too scared to like speak or open yourself up or say the wrong thing and then you start to become I've had I had moments where I I felt like I was becoming very like not like like a robot but

like I had to be very meticulous about what I was saying and very agreeable and can't say the wrong thing and like and it just starts to become this very like weird way of feeling where you feel like you just can't be expressive and you can't be yourself and then that was where it came in with like wanting to do YouTube and trying to have a space within this age of the internet and this age of social media where I can say this is who I actually am take it or leave it like me or not this is who I am and I felt like actually taking this step to even though at times it was really uncomfortable for me taking the step of being like I'm proud of who I am and this is my personality and like this is gonna sound probably so corny but like to me I've always felt like I was just like a girl from [__] New York oh my God this is gonna sound so cringe I grew up to me I felt like very normal and like I am from a small town called Nyack that is like a 27:01 suburb of New York City and I woke up every day and like I was homeschooled and like did ballet and like to me I feel like I've remained that same person of course life has changed drastically but like at the core I feel like I am proud of who I am at the at the core like I know I've always been that that same person and I feel very rooted and grounded and I grew up very grounded and rooted and of course I came from a famous family everybody you know that's the reality of my life can't change that either um and I just feel like again people didn't really like know me and know my story and know the kind of person I was like people don't know what kind of friend I am they don't know what kind of daughter I am they don't know what kind of sister I am like but I know.

Alex: You are starting to share more and even in the video that you made where you basically asked people to stop harassing you and you're like leave me alone just leave me.

Hailey Bieber: I was like half joking but I was being half serious like it was supposed to be something that was like light and funny but I was also being serious because I like woke up one day and I was like I can't believe we're still doing this.

Alex: Because what you like read a comment

Hailey Bieber: Yeah like I was I which again like I have to stop myself from doing all the time because we know that the internet is a toxic hole and like comments are a toxic hole but I was just like curious about something and then I'm like reading I'm like are we still talking about this like we're getting to this has been for it's been years now like four years we've been together like come on.

Alex: Let it go

Hailey Bieber: Let's all evolve together let's hold hands and and really like okay we're done like that's how I wanted to that's how I felt in that moment I was like are we serious that this is what we're still doing like we're still gonna harass me about this this [__] there is so much that I could have said there was so much that I at times was like this close to saying and I just felt like there's so there's so many things that were happening where it's also like there's a time and a place and there's also a time and a place to let other people express what they need to express and like go through their feelings and emotions and like I just felt like there were certain times if I was going to say something it was going to make things way worse and not be beneficial again it was going to be my word against

someone else's against a bunch of other people and it would just not be beneficial and I've struggled with that for I I had struggled with that for a long time like I would talk to my therapist and be like but it's it's not fair that people think that this is what happened when this is really what happened and then there you get into a cycle of like again feeling the need to explain yourself and for me it's not even about explaining myself it's about people knowing the truth because there's a truth there is actually the truth of something that happened and there's the truth of what didn't happen so I think for me when people you know make up stories about me online I'm just like but that's not what happened that's not the truth

Alex: Is the Crux of it the homewrecker thing like is that what really bothers you

Hailey Bieber: I think there's a lot of timing and timeline stuff that like just wasn't true and that's also just the internet making up their stories and like taking little bits and pieces of something they're looking at from the outside and there it and by the way it's not even it's so many different things the internet can make up they can literally sit here and say that I threw up on you know

Alex: Which she did

Hailey Bieber: But that's not okay and you can sit there and say Haley threw up on me it was really crazy and then I would read that on TMZ and I'd be like that did not happen do you know what I'm saying there's just stuff that happens all the time that I'm like hello.

Alex: Can you explain what happened when you were taking photos on the red carpet with your husband at the Met Gala in 2021.

Hailey Bieber: Oh and people were screaming so yes I could hear everyone screaming and again I think there's a certain part of you that has a numbness of just like I was like really surprised I could kind of hear it but I didn't know if that's what was really going on until I saw the video after the whole thing of everybody being like oh he's trying to tell her not to cry that was not true it wasn't making me cry um although it's a very disrespectful thing to do towards anybody I felt like I had something in my eye that was see that's just what goes to show you how out of context things can be seen when he's like trying to help me I'm like I feel like there's something in my eye do you see something in my eye and I'm going like this and he's like no no you're good.

Alex: And as this is happening everyone's chanting was it there was it I don't even know if it was their relationship name or just her name so then you take the sunglasses.

Hailey Bieber: Yeah and the sunglasses were just part of my look they were just part of my look I knew I was gonna wear the sunglasses regardless on the carpet for some photos and then some without um but yeah I did hear people yelling I it wasn't making me almost cry um I think seeing the video back after made me like damn like that sucks that that's the energy people are like putting out into like that you would even spend your time.

Alex: Camping out

Hailey Bieber: Standing outside and doing that I just felt like it was it was disrespectful to me to my relationship it just was period the end but I think I've endured so much disrespect and I still do to this day that there was like a part of me that was just like another day another negative sleigh.

Alex: It is so depressing

Hailey Bieber: I know that I know

Alex: That's like a very public example I feel like of you having to go through that is there anything that comes to mind that was supposed to be a happy moment for you for you and Justin whatever and it was ruined by harassment or bullying or this concept of his past.

Hailey Bieber: They've never ruined anything for me they've never they've never they're not ruining my life they're not ruining my happiness and that I think is really the win of the whole thing you're actually not taking anything away from me so that's what I just keep stepping forward with it's like you can't take this away from me you cannot take away my happiness my relationship um my business my career like you just you can you can try and you can be mad about it but it doesn't change anything is my point.

Alex: Haley what do you think the internet wants you to do

Hailey Bieber: I don't know I legit don't know

Alex: like if you were trying to get under it like

Hailey Bieber: I'm like sometimes I joke around I'm like would they be happy if I like just moved away and like locked myself in a house and just like I don't know I don't know I don't know what the goal is that's what's so funny is I'm just like I don't try to understand like what is the goal

Alex: I think I would say

Hailey Bieber: A lot of the time it's a 10 I think it's attention I think a lot of people sometimes they do things and they say things in hopes to get a response out of you and to get a rise and I've seen it happen with a lot of other people too like you're ugly and then like you respond and you're like I wish you the best like I'm sorry you feel that way and they're like oh my God queen I'm sorry I actually love you I was just being silly

Alex: You're like that was

Hailey Bieber: That wasn't funny

Alex: That wasn't funny at all calling me ugly like I guess it is kind of funny because look at you so [__] off

Hailey Bieber: No it's just like what was your point so then the point is like they get the attention that they thought I think a lot of people think you'll not respond and I've had that happen before too I didn't think you would see it I'm sorry and I'm like so why are you saying it are you just bored like I don't know

Alex: Can you try to explain what does it feel like to have millions of people against your relationship like what does that feel like on a day-to-day basis to you

Hailey Bieber: I guess the biggest thing is like I think it's sad I think it's sad to be against someone's happiness I think it's sad to not wish somebody well who am I supposed to be that would be acceptable and then that means that I'm living for other people and that means that I'm being a people pleaser which I struggle with a lot I do want people to like me it does bother me when people just don't like me simply because of the rumors they've heard or the ideas they've come up with or things that they've seen like it makes me sad but I think I've had to come to the point in the realization of like there is no way that you exist as a person especially not as a person with a platform in the public eye where everybody loves you and

that's even in life in general even if I was just in a normal situation not everybody's gonna like you I'm just existing in front of a lot of people so it's very easy to make up your like make decisions about how you feel about someone yeah especially when there's so much access to look at them and see what they're doing in their social media and there's photos and there's just like life so I don't know I think that sometimes it feels really heavy.

Alex: What has been your lowest moment since all of this began

Hailey Bieber: When things can get really dark and you can start having thoughts of like it not being worth it anymore or not wanting to be here anymore which I have had before in the past and um coming out of that I think it's really important a support system is like the most important thing for sure

Alex: Maybe if you could talk about like the shame of having those feelings because I bet a lot of people listening have had those thoughts and your you're you're really alone with them and how to even like comprehend them is a is a process in itself

Hailey Bieber: Sometimes I don't think we can comprehend them on our own because then you just throw yourself back into like a vicious cycle I do think sometimes you need to express it and you need to go to someone who is going to feel safe for you and support you in those thoughts not make you feel like you're crazy or that you're wrong for feeling dark and deep and heavy there's also this like kind of weird Twisted thing where I'm like I don't get to feel that way because I have an amazing life and I'm so blessed and I'm so fortunate so like it's almost like my my dialogue in my head feels like get the [__] over it like you don't get to feel that way because there are people in this world that are that are really struggling and you're not like that's sometimes how I feel like I talk to myself because I'm like get over it like you're fine that kind of a thing and I've had to really try to be more gentle with myself and like allow myself I'm somebody who like I hate crying in front of people I don't do it like just don't like it and it's been since I was a little kid and I I've never understood I mean I've started to a little bit more in therapy and stuff but I'm like why do I find it so embarrassing to cry in front of people when it's like everybody cries and it's such a vulnerable thing but I'm like it feels so awkward and like cringe to me to cry in front of people and it's always been such an uncomfortable thing for me so like I have when I say I'm like shy and stuff like like I have been guarded emotionally in ways since I was like a little girl so I think going through the process of also trying to understand why we have some of the Tendencies we have since childhood like what are the things that have happened to me when I was a little kid that have like brought me to the place of feeling like I have to have the self-dialogue of like you don't get to feel that way get the [__] over it people are way worse off than you which is also like true there are people who are going through a lot different struggles and different things but it's the sense of lot invalidating the way that I feel and I'm still working on that and I'm 100 sure that I will be forever working on that in December going into the new year I went to this place that was a like therapy intensive I was there for seven days no phone literally therapy like hours and hours a day and that was something that we spoke about about like tiptoeing around the way I feel or like not sticking up for myself because again it kind of boils back to like I've never

enjoyed confrontation and I think a lot of it comes from my mom is a very sweet woman who is just like an angel but she as far as I can remember she never liked confrontation and she I feel like didn't stick up for herself and at times still to this day doesn't say what she wants and is like I don't want to do this I want to do this like she is a very just gentle kind of reserved pulled back woman and there's so much about her that I like super respect but I think it's just a pattern that I watched growing up of just she was just very um non-confrontational and there was a lot we didn't talk about there was subjects we danced around and as I've as I've gotten older and had open conversations with my mom and she's expressed things that have happened to her and her life and things that she's gone through that I never knew about it made me understand why she might be like that but it's a it's a pattern and it's like a learned behaviour I think a little bit that I am trying to move past and work past

Alex: To close out kind of the chapter of what everything we were discussing what would you say to her fans like just coming from your heart they're all sitting listening to you having an open mind let's pretend they had it what would you say to her fans?

Hailey Bieber: I think I would say the first thing I would say is you're not obligated to like me but I believe that no matter what there can always be mutual respect between people and to me that means just you don't have to say anything you don't have to like me but you don't have to say anything either because behind this person that you're looking at on a screen is a person with a brain and a heart and emotions and issues that I face and and so do you and so does Alex and so does every single person in this room so you just yeah I think just Mutual like respect and decency and and know that what you say can have impact and know that yeah I guess that's what I would say

Alex: Oh my God I think I would have been a little nastier but I love it from you Haley

Hailey Bieber: I mean what I want to say would be no I'm just kidding no like that I always made the joke of like I think if I sat down with any of those people and they would walk away being like you know what I get it like I respect her for that I think we will always have more in common than we don't that's like where everything comes from for me so when I see people being nasty and like attacking me I'm like we probably like a lot of the same things.

Alex: One of my last questions on this topic because I'm just trying to get all of it just like let's wrap it in a bow yeah so you never have to talk about this again you're like yeah I wish

Hailey Bieber: No I literally never will no I'm like sweating

Alex: At any point did Justin or any literally anyone ever ask his ex to help put an end to the harassment that her fans put you through.

Hailey Bieber: No what I will say is that she has been in this industry much longer than I have and maybe there's something that she knows about like it wouldn't fix anything

Alex: I think like a nice little heart on your Tick Tock could end it all

Hailey Bieber: The thing is too is like I think that like all everyone is just trying to like create separation even though there's clearly like not always separation I

have no expectation I would never expect someone to do that for me like she doesn't owe me anything I don't owe neither of us owe anybody anything except like respect I respect her a lot and I think that like there's just no expectations if that was something that she felt was necessary then that would be amazing but I I just yeah I respect her there's no drama personally

Alex: Have you guys ever spoken

Hailey Bieber: Yes

Alex: And then like recently no I don't guess not recently But like after your marriage

Hailey Bieber: Yes so that's why I'm like it's all respect it's all love that's also why I feel like well if everybody on our side knows what happened and we're good and we could walk away from it with Clarity and respect then like right that's fine

Alex: As long as you know you're good that's really all that matters

Hailey Bieber: Which had brought me a lot of peace and I'm like hey we know what happened it is what it is you're never going to be able to like correct every narrative and there's going to be new ones that come it's never going to end and that's why I get to the point where I'm like that's why I didn't speak about a lot of this stuff because I'm like there'll be something new there'll probably be something new from this interview

Alex: Of course

Hailey Bieber: Then I'm just like

Alex: You don't want to know what's going to come from this interview Haley Bieber talking about sex

Hailey Bieber: Great

Alex: I need to give the fans what they want right okay we need to just give them a little a little taste right walk me through your face walk me through step by step your sex with Justin Bieber

Hailey Bieber: Oh my God

Alex: I was gonna try to do it's so like so sorry [__] psycho no I was wondering does anyone ever ask you about your sex life

Hailey Bieber: No actually

Alex: We're the first ones over here

Hailey Bieber: I don't think so

Alex: Are you a morning sex or night sex people?

Hailey Bieber: More so night

Alex: Me too

Hailey Bieber: But I do like morning too it's so funny because I talk about this stuff and the reason I get weird about talking about it is because I'm like if my parents are gonna listen to this there's something that feels so cringe no about your parents

Alex: Oh hopefully they don't make it this far

Hailey Bieber: Your your parents are probably really Progressive and like

Alex: True Haley but I grew up fully Catholic

Hailey Bieber: Okay

Alex: So my parents like really it call her Daddy really like I went from zero to like oh my God what is she doing yeah but they get over it this will see this is your introduction like

Hailey Bieber: I also I'm married that people like don't care about married people sex

Alex: I'm sorry you two are the hottest people in the world

Hailey Bieber: Absolutely not like I don't think anybody cares

Alex: Oh I care okay so your night sex people we love that okay this is so graphic but I'm saying the words

Hailey Bieber: Okay

Alex: For the rest of your life you have to pick one of the two

Hailey Bieber: Okay

Alex: From Mr Bieber are you going to be fingered or eaten out for the rest of your life you can only take one

Hailey Bieber: Hmm that's very hard because I feel like it's always a combination

Alex: Has anyone ever tried to have a threesome with you

Hailey Bieber: Like in our relationship?

Alex: Ehem

Hailey Bieber: No

Alex: Would you be down

Hailey Bieber: No it's funny because I feel like those ideas can be really fun and like sound really exciting I think at the at the point that of inside of R it doesn't work for the two of us we personally like that wouldn't work for this because because I think sometimes for some people it it does so I've so I've heard some people are in like open relationships and like it works for a time but I feel like in the end it always doesn't end up working so I think the second you make the decision to do that there is never going back from that and I just don't know that I would ever be willing to like we've worked very hard we worked very hard to like be in the space that we're in now and like trusting each other and there's like such a beautiful trust and bond that I just don't think that's something I would be comfortable with or him for that matter

Alex: Can you expand a little bit on how you guys built that trust and that Bond

Hailey Bieber: Um he's really honest like brutally honest overly honest I could ask him about any person any past girl anything and he'd be like oh yeah like this this and this like he doesn't have a problem being explicit and I think that made me trust him a lot because I'm like there's nothing I don't know

Alex: Because you can tell when someone's being shady

Hailey Bieber: And then when they dance around her like he's had people like DM I'm gonna be like oh like show me the DMs like do you know like be like do you think that like this person's trying to be nice or you think this is weird and I'm like I think it's weird no it's like he knows he's just saying like do you think like this person is like genuine because it'll come across like super friendly and unless like there's just no reason

Alex: There's no reason you need to have a relationship

Hailey Bieber: Yeah yeah but I'm also someone where like I really encourage female friendships because I think that you have to be able to have like healthy opposite sex relationships that are friendships um or else you're like closing yourself off all the time and it's like

Alex: But you're not like having Instagram models like walk around your house

Hailey Bieber: No of course I'm just saying like of course there's boundaries with everything but totally I'm just saying like don't be afraid to have girlfriends

Alex: Totally right because it's like if you can't it's like oh my God like

Hailey Bieber: If I could be like if I couldn't have friends that were guys I think you control what the limitations are in any relationship and any friendship and any work relationship

Alex: Like you can have self-restraint and

Hailey Bieber: Yeah yeah yeah for sure

Alex: Do you have people still in your DMs I feel like I am just I am just amazed

Hailey Bieber: I don't have people hitting me up like

Alex: I'll slide

Hailey Bieber: My idea

Alex: About you okay do you and Justin have the same favorite positions

Hailey Bieber: I think so it's not like I'm like I strictly like this one thing and he strictly likes another thing

Alex: Can you give us like one or two or five

Hailey Bieber: It's always different

Alex: Okay yeah

Hailey Bieber: It's always something different

Alex: You're moving it around

Hailey Bieber: Yeah well no I mean like one day it might be one thing one day it might be another

Alex: Oh I actually didn't even do that too I was like you're doing 10 positions in one night she's like he's flipping you upside down one second

Alex: And you guys have like you guys are not set on one position like you guys have a couple go to's

Hailey Bieber: No no no

Alex: I end up with my boyfriend I have now like our go-to like three I feel like every couple has those like go-to's

Hailey Bieber: Yeah

Alex: Do you want to give us one and it can't be missionary

Hailey Bieber: It's definitely not a missionary I really like doggy style

Alex: You heard it here that was beautiful Haley what is the sexiest thing Justin does to turn you on

Hailey Bieber: You know it can be so many different things it can be like a connection thing it can be a physical thing for me kissing is a big deal like that's a that's a big thing for me it always has been just like in my life before I was married so I would say that is probably the most

Alex: What is the sexiest thing you do that turns him on or what's his thing that he always says like oh God like Haley like he like gets him going

Hailey Bieber: The connection point is very important to him of like we could literally just be like laying down talking before and like just having like a really fun conversation and like that is really who's important for him yeah

Alex: Okay I'm gonna tell you something that I think is super sexy about you that turns me on is voting.

Hailey Bieber: Yes voting is hot

Alex: So sexy

Hailey Bieber : Yeah

Alex: So sexy

Hailey Bieber: Justin can't vote here but oh

Alex :Well he'll be he'll be supportive of us both okay

Hailey Bieber: He's very

Alex: And there are so many people that listen to this show and this airs in September we have a huge election in November and I just think it would be great to use the end of this episode and use this platform and our platforms to just emphasize why it's important to vote and just how much everyone needs to get out there so why is voting in this year's election important to you Haley

Hailey Bieber: It's important to me because I think as everybody knows we're in a very scary state in our country um we as women are living through a very terrifying reality right now um and I think what we've learned what I took away in a big way from the overturn of Roe v Wade was the people that we elect in our states in our cities in our counties they are so important um and that was something that I was like [__] like we got this is really the reality we gotta get on it um I felt very passionate the last election about just please get him out of there like that was like it felt like legit like life or death and it and it was in so many ways um and I still feel that even even more now because you've seen there's still so many terrible scary things happening within our country but I do think there's a chance for like change and I always think there's an opportunity for Change and there's an opportunity to come together and stand up and make a difference

Alex: You've been open about the fact that people in your family have different political views than you and I think that's probably the most relatable thing we'll talk about on the podcast today and I think so many people can relate to that how did you navigate that because it can get heated

Hailey Bieber: Yeah it was tricky um especially very personally like my my dad my parents um it just got to a point where I found that we couldn't discuss it which I think is okay um I believe what I believe I am a fully formed woman now 25 turning 26 I know what I believe in and what I don't um I know what I stand for and what I don't and obviously it's disappointing that the people that raised you could think so differently than you and have such a different perception that sounds crazy and you're just like how did I come from you then I just don't get this but it would it just causes too much disturbance and turmoil and argumentative back and forth that it's just like it just can't be talked about

Alex: You're not going to change people

Hailey Bieber: And it's funny because me and my sister have the same exact point of view which is like nice because at least I'm like at least I go like at least

and then my mom like I'll try to talk to her about something she's like I'm from Brazil so I'm like okay my mom's from Brazil by the way

Alex: Oh my God no I I appreciate that I think it's always good to just one normalize people are gonna have different views but I do think regardless like just get out and vote because it is so important this year specificall

Hailey Bieber: For sure so and it's not something that I even you know the last election was super vocal about it I plan to do that every single time um it's something that I'm passionate about for sure so I appreciate you bringing it up

Alex: Hailey Bieber Thank you so much for coming on Call her daddy.I really appreciate you opening up.You don't do a lot of long form interviews, so I appreciate you trusting, me and sitting down.

Hailey Bieber: Of course, Thank you. I think I An expectation where I know coming on here with you, you're gonna go there. That's just the reality of the situation, I wouldn't have agreed to it, if I didn't know that was the case here, I think there's a lot that I've avoided speaking on for a long time that it is my life.So I should be able to like say what I want about it, you go there in certain contexts where it's like I've not gone before and I think that that's like a personal challenge to myself that I want, I wanted to like push myself Like, you know, it's okay to be on, like, I was uncomfortable multiple times in this conference are inside of the couch. Because I was like, how many like protective body positions that I get into? I folded like a pretzel.
