Clashes between *perguruan silat* frequently happen. This is based on the attitude of fanaticism. This attitude is developed from a collective pride. The pride is associated theoretically with the concept of social identity and collective self-esteem (Rubin & Hewstone, 1998). This study is aimed to find out the differences in collective pride among the mass at several *perguruan silat*. This study uses pride theory proposed by Sullivan (2013) which collective pride is characterized into a positive emotion, a high social identity, and a high collective self-esteem.

This study involves 150 respondents from the member of kera sakti, setia hati, and pagar nusa which are 50 people of each group. The measurement of the collective pride consists of 24 items, the validity from 0.272 to 0.910, and the reliability is 0.908.

The result shows that there are differences in collective pride level of the member of perguruan silat *Kera Sakti, Setia hati, and Pagar Nusa*, which are kera sakti (mean: 63.56), pagar nusa (mean: 72.74), and setia hati (mean: 67.54). This indicates their significant differences in Collective Pride against the *groups*, regarding the test result of F using Anova resulting that F value =7.036 p=0.01 (p= 0.01 =Significant).
