

## ABSTRACT

Parenting parents parents a way to educate and guide the child in the form of daily interactions. Emotional intelligence is a personal and social abilities that should be owned by every person. The purpose of this study to determine the level of parenting parents who applied, to determine the level of emotional intelligence, and to determine whether there is influence between parenting parents on emotional intelligence of students in State Junior High School 2 Kelampok Village, Singosari District Malang.

This research is a quantitative study and correlation of its kind that aims to discover whether there is influence between two variables. Data collection methods such as questionnaires and documentation. From a population of class VIII A to H State Junior High School 2 Kelampok Village, Singosari District Malang totaling 288 students, thus sampled is 25% of the total is  $288 - 25\% = 72$  students. The analysis uses multiple regression test using SPSS version 16.0.

In authoritarian parenting, there are 8 people or 11% for the high category, there are 40 people or 56% for the medium category, and 24 people or 33% for the low category. In democratic parenting amounted to 12 people or 17% for the high category, totaling 14 people, or 19% for the low category and 46 people or 64% for the medium category. From the results of this research is that results in the child's level of emotional intelligence State Junior High School 2 Kelampok Village, Singosari District Malang included in the medium category, premises mean of 76.16 and has a number of 51 people or 71% .From correlation results showed that parenting (authoritarian, democratic, permissive) are not no influence parenting parents to students' emotional intelligence in State Junior High School 2 Kelampok Village, Singosari District Malang. It can be concluded that not only parenting that can affect students' emotional intelligence on State Junior High School 2 Kelampok Village, Singosari District Malang.
