Sexual abuse is a sadistic act to the victim and society. The victim can be from both man and woman. On the other side, the abuser can be done by adults or children. The sexual abusers have their own specialties, starting from triggering factor to the labile thinking of the child. So the solutions for adult and child abuser are different.

The problem rose is whether children committed to a crime are triggered by the society, family, or by their sexual development phase. These problems are interesting to be discussed and monitored for their cause by the children profiles.

The purpose of the study is to find out the profiles of children committed to sexual abuse. This study is a social-physiological research using qualitative method with phenomenology's strategy. The location of the research is in Child's prison Class II A in Blitar with 5 children as the subjects whom are the prisoners of immoral and sexual crimes.

The result of the study shows that the children committed to a crime are caused and motivated by their friend. But that is not the only cause. It is started from their broken families which cause them to feel inconvenient with their parents, so the children choose to find their own happiness with their friends that unfortunately bring them to commit crimes including sexual abuse. In addition, this time the child shows positive and negative emotions after being in custody and appeared in the form of future-oriented expectations after coming out of custody
